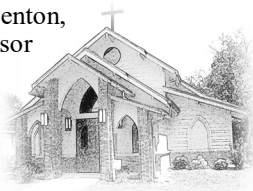


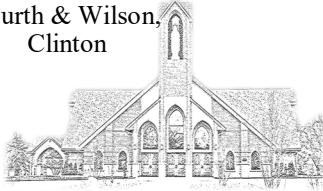

MISSOURI BISHOPS STATEMENT ON ABORTION BALLOT INITIATIVE

The Missouri bishops, through the Missouri Catholic Conference, have issued a statement opposing the abortion ballot initiative. The statement reads, in part, “A misleading proposed amendment to the Missouri Constitution suggests that a ‘right to an abortion’ is needed to protect women, while the amendment could actually put women at risk and endanger preborn children. This ballot initiative would legalize abortions in this state and remove long standing health and safety standards for women. In addition, this initiative does nothing to reduce or eliminate the underlying social causes for abortion and does not further a true culture of life in the state. “Groups are currently collecting citizen signatures to add the amendment to the November 2024 ballot. **We encourage all Catholics and people of good will to not sign any petition that would put this amendment on the ballot.**” To read the full statement, please [click here](#).

Commandment of the Month: This month's featured Commandment of the Month is the 7th Commandment, ***"You shall not steal."*** This is one of those Commandments that most people feel they have under control. This is true, regarding physical possessions; but not so true regarding possessions that are not physical. Consider a person's reputation. Might you 'steal' someone's reputation by talking about them behind their back in order to bolster your image? How about stealing someone's peace of mind by gossiping or by being mean? Don't we steal someone's time when we arrive late, either intentionally or out of negligence, causing someone to waste their time waiting? All forms of stealing demonstrate selfishness and that we aren't living the Commandment, "Love your neighbor as yourself." During the season of Lent, give some thought to the intangible forms of stealing and reflect on any opportunities where improvement is warranted.
