I am pleased to announce that we now have a new sound system at Star of the Sea Church. We were all thrilled to have such a powerful sound system. As long as we maintain it carefully, we may not have to worry about the system in our church. I would like to thank all those who contributed to this sound system. Secondly, as we already know, the Lenten season for this year, 2024, starts with Ash Wednesday on February 14th, 2024. There will be a Lenten retreat for Star of the Sea and Gold Beach on Tuesday, February 13th, 2024. The theme of this retreat is "**Preparing ourselves for Lent.**"

The retreat program will include a **30-minute talk** about the invitation to follow Christ during the Lenten Season, followed by Eucharistic Adoration for **25 minutes**, and then Holy Mass.

Importance of Stations of the Cross to all Catholics during the Lenten Season

During the Lenten season, all Catholics are invited to participate in the Stations of the Cross, a spiritual exercise that allows us to walk in the footsteps of Jesus. This exercise helps us reflect on the spiritual possibility of turning away from our sins and reminds us how our sins wound Jesus each time we commit them. By doing so, it encourages us to develop a new conscience and love as Jesus Christ did. We were all forgiven and saved by Jesus on the Cross because God loves us so much. As John 3:16 says, "For God so loved the world that He gave His Only Son." We are called to do the same for one another, just as Christ did for us. We will have Stations of the Cross every Friday during the Lenten season.

Stations of the Cross Schedule in Brookings and Gold Beach

In Brookings, the Stations of the Cross will start at 4:35 p.m. in English, followed by soup in the hall, and another station at 5:30 p.m. in Spanish.

In Gold Beach, the Stations of the Cross will start at 12:10 p.m. in English.
