
IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Eucharistic Reflection

Some people have asked me why it's necessary to receive Holy Communion by mouth or tongue when one can also receive it by hand. To answer this, we need to understand the significance of the Holy Eucharist and the theology behind it. The Holy Eucharist is considered the highest form of prayer, with Jesus Christ as the main celebrant at every Mass, represented by the priest acting in the person of Christ.

When we participate in the Holy Eucharist, we are in God's presence in His temple, participating actually and actively, in the redemptive work of Christ for our salvation, as it was done on Calvary, but made present to us in sacramental form at every Mass. This understanding helps us to comprehend the transformative effect of every Mass in our lives.

While the Church permits both methods of receiving Communion, receiving on the tongue is seen as an act of deep humility and reverence to God, considering that we are not even worthy to touch Him. This gesture, according to theologian and bishop Schneider, expresses the attitude of being like a child before the greatness of God, who is present in the Sacred Host.



In essence, whether receiving by hand or tongue, a deep attitude of reverence is required. The Archdiocese has released a sample video demonstrating the proper way of receiving Holy Communion by either hand or tongue, which will be reviewed at Mass soon. This year of Eucharistic revival presents an opportunity for us to reflect deeply on the Holy Eucharist. Understanding the significance of the Holy Mass and approaching it with humility is crucial.

I also want to express appreciation to the parishioners in Brookings who have started observing moments of silence after Mass, allowing people to pray. Special thanks to Sister Christabel SJS for facilitating this with the collaboration of the Ushers in a great pastoral manner.
