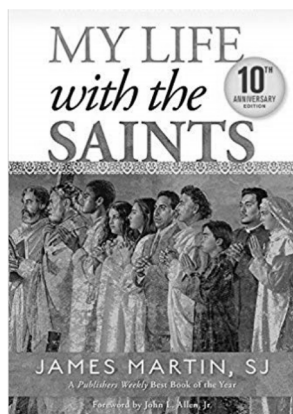

Important reminders for parents whose children are preparing to receive the following sacraments in 2019-2020:

First Holy Communion & Reconciliation:

Two-year sacramental preparation program beginning in 1st grade. In accordance with Archdiocesan guidelines, children are required to complete two years of religious education to be properly prepared to meet Jesus in these two sacraments.

Confirmation: This is a three-year program. The third year includes group meetings, Confirmation retreat, the Sacrament of Confirmation, and five monthly Mystagogy events following Confirmation.

***Please note:** If your child needs to receive Sacraments but is beyond the typical grade level, please contact Lisa Gramlich at l_gramlich@stpatricksmarin.org, so we can find a way to accommodate your child. If your child is new to St. Patrick Church and has had preparation elsewhere, please let us know so that we can place them accordingly. All are welcome!
