

A Reflection from Deacon Matthew Ferch

This week, on June 24, we celebrate the birth of St. John the Baptist. This is a little-known solemnity because it is usually celebrated during the week and with little fanfare, so many do not have the opportunity to celebrate it. However, we ought to commemorate it because John the Baptist did so much to prepare the people of his time (as well as us) that Jesus is coming. We need to think about how we are preparing ourselves for the coming of

We usually give attention to John the Baptist during Advent, but it is good to reflect on his impact throughout the year. As we know from the Gospel of Luke, John is a cousin of Jesus. After Mary was told she was going to be the Mother of God, she rushes to see Elizabeth. John leaps in Elizabeth's womb because he knows he is in the presence of Jesus, the Christ—the one who will redeem the world. After John was born and grew into adulthood, he went out into the wilderness dressed in camel's-hair, eating locusts and honey, and he was baptizing people. He shouted, "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight His paths" (Lk. 3:4). He prepares the people by saying, "one mightier than I is coming" (Lk. 3:16). He makes the people think about how they are preparing themselves for Jesus. From being in the womb to his martyrdom, John always knew and pointed to others where Christ is.

St. John the Baptist does the same for us today. He is the prophet who testifies and points out who Christ, the Messiah is. We believe that Christ will come again at the end of the world, but we do not know the day or the hour, so we must prepare ourselves for the coming of Christ by heeding John's prophetic words (Mt. 25:13). How are we preparing for the coming of Christ? Hopefully, it is through faith and good works. Hopefully, we are conforming our lives to Christ's by listening to the advice of John, "He must increase; I must decrease" (Jn. 4:30).
