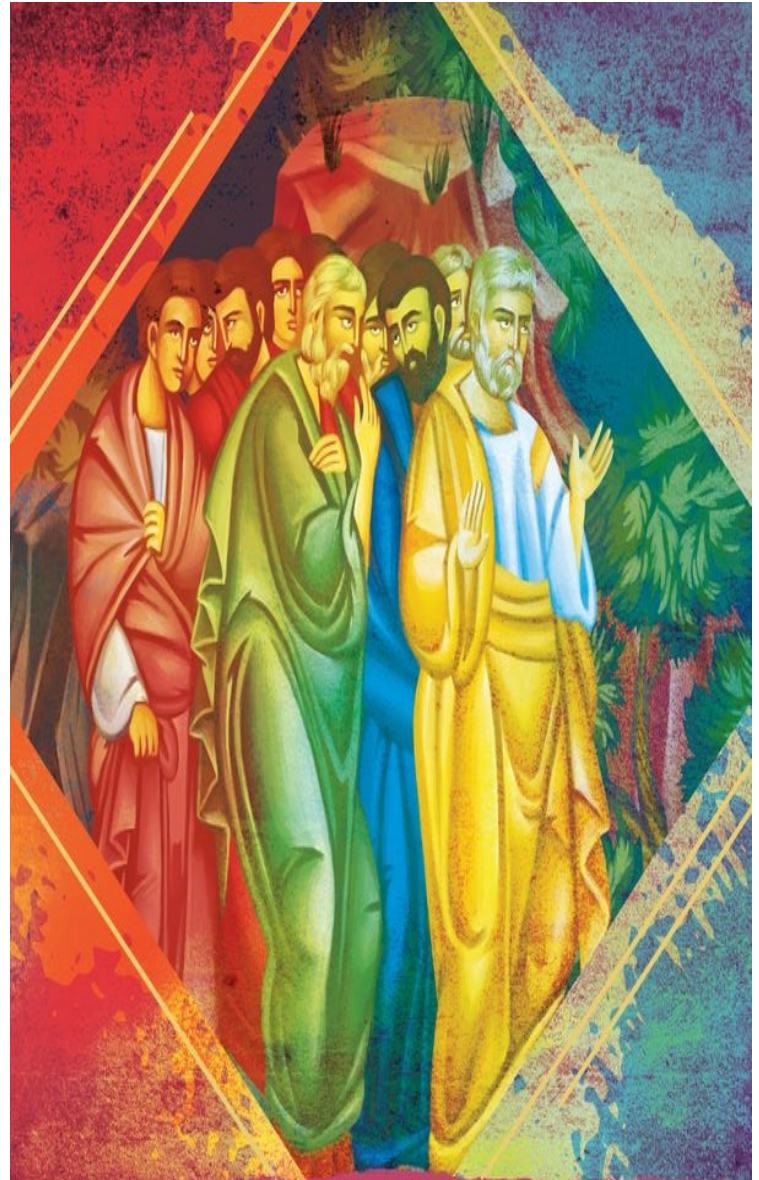

Finance Council Members Needed

Every parish in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee is required to have a Parish Finance Council. We have a Finance Council here at Blessed Sacrament, but in order to be more effective, we need new members to rotate in and out. At the present moment, we are in need of several new members to join this Council. In particular, we are looking for any members who might have some degree of financial expertise, though that is not required.

What is the purpose of the Finance Council?

- To provide advice and guidance to the pastor in the administration of parish assets.
- To prepare the parish budget, any budgets for extraordinary expenditures, and review financial statements.
- To monitor the financial condition of the parish
- To provide assistance in the formulation and communication of an annual financial report to the parish community.
- Other as needed financial consultations.

What are the requirements to serve the Finance Council?

- Baptized, practicing Catholics
- Registered members of Blessed Sacrament
- Participants in the parish worship life, especially Mass and the Sacraments
- At least 25 years of age
- Selected because of their familiarity with financial matters and related expertise

This Council meets regularly in the Pope Room located in the Parish Rectory on the 2nd Tuesday of the month at 6:30 PM. The term of office for at-large members is three years and is limited to two consecutive terms.
