

Wasting Food

Dear Friends,

My brothers and sisters and I grew up with hunger. Food was both precious and scarce. My father was a barber and so there was a little money to keep up our supply of rice. There were families that were a lot worse off than ours. So many times there'd be a desperate villager at our door asking to "borrow" a cup of rice to feed their family. My mother never sent anyone away emptyhanded.

My hunger certainly ended when I came to Canada! The food may have been different and often strange to me but boy, there was so very much of it! Often the amounts placed on an individual's plate, I thought, could have fed a whole family back home!

Food is a blessing and we are so very blessed to be living here in Canada where there is plenty. Unfortunately, there is also a great deal of waste. I grew up hearing that food is sacred and to waste it is sinful.

Jesus had this to say about wasting food: "And when they had eaten their fill, he told his disciples, "Gather up the leftover fragments, that nothing may be lost."

"Behold, this was the guilt of your sister Sodom: she and her daughters had pride, excess of food, and prosperous ease, but did not aid the poor and needy."

God commands us not to waste food. He also teaches how to avoid it. Jesus believed in sharing. If we make too much of something the food could be

shared with someone. Leftover food could be frozen to use up at another time. This also saves money that could be used to feed the hungry.

Jesus didn't care that He multiplied the loaves and fish by performing a miracle to make it happen because *all food* is a miracle made by God. It really is *a sin* to waste food when there are so many people in the world who don't have enough- and that's something I can personally attest to!




Week of Prayer for Christian Unity (Jan 18-25)
