

Lent





Dear Friends,

We are now on the 10^{th} day of the holy season of Lent. It is a liturgical season of forty days reflecting the forty days Jesus spent in the desert in fasting and prayer.

Jesus underwent great fear, humiliation, immense suffering and death on your behalf. That's how much He *loves* you! That's how much He *values* you! If God finds *you* worthy enough to undergo all that suffering and torture for, what will you do *for Him* this season? Will you love *yourself* enough to consider yourself worthy to serve Him?

Lent is a time of intense spiritual renewal. It's a time for each of us to experience *a reawakening* of our relationship with God through *penance and prayer*.

Penance may consist of *fasting* from some much-loved food (all Sundays during Lent are excluded from fasting since every Sunday is the Lord's day) or *abstaining* from a favourite activity (a tv show, limiting your time on your cell phone, computer, etc) *or* it may consist of *doing* something nice for others on a daily basis.

It's a call to deep self-examination and this is a great time to see you celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation. It's a time for taking a good look at our attitude and behaviour towards others. Remember, when we serve others, we serve our God.

When we love others, we love our God. We *grow* spiritually and become more Christlike.

Lent calls us to spend more *time* with God in prayer. There is never a shortage in our lives for needed prayer. The problems and tragedies of the world can at times overwhelm us and leave us feeling helpless. Let's pray earnestly for the Russia-Ukraine war to come to an end soon. When we pray, we join our voices in unison with those of the saints that have gone before us. God hears our prayers. We must never underestimate the effect our prayers have before God.

Lent invites us to come back to the Lord with all our hearts. Let's use this time to get closer to our God, praise Him more, repent and refresh our spiritual energy.

REFLECTIONS ON GOSPEL READING – Matthew 17:1-9

In Scripture, the mountain is an essential place of encounter with the divine. It is no coincidence that God's revelation of who Jesus is takes place on a mountaintop. Here Jesus is linked to all the signs of God's revelation: a mountain, a light, a voice, and holy fear. In Matthew this event takes place after the prediction of Jesus' death in Jerusalem, pointing to God's plan in both this dazzling revelation and to the upcoming death on a cross.



- 1. What word, phrase, or thought speaks to you most strongly?
- 2.Is there a connection between Jesus' clothes being "dazzling white" and the symbol of the white garment we use in the baptismal rite?
- 3. What kinds of "mountaintop" experiences have you had? How did they affect you?




