



Prayer



"God shapes the world by prayer. The more praying there is in the world the better the world will be, the mightier the forces against evil." – **Mother Teresa**

Dear Friends,

Prayer is powerful! It connects us with our almighty God. It allows us to seek His guidance and blessings. It has the power to shape the world. When we pray, we communicate with our God and share our hopes and desires with Him. In doing so, we are expressing our faith and trust in God's ability to bring about positive changes. We invite God to intervene in our circumstances and to transform them according to His will. Look at all that Mother Theresa was able to accomplish through prayer!

A few years ago, I was attending an ecumenical meeting on prayer. One of the attendees looked at me and stated that she did not understand why *some people* pray for those who are deceased. "What good does that serve", she said, "It's nothing but a waste of time!"

While I didn't want to enter into dispute with anyone, I felt I had to gently share a different point of view on the subject. It's true that the dead are no longer *physically* present in this world but prayer is still beneficial for them in the afterlife. First of all,

prayer is *never* a waste of time! Secondly, while *we* may be bound by a linear time line while we live here on earth, God is *not* bound by our earthly laws. Our prayers today for a deceased loved one can have all sorts of beneficial effects for that individual. Our prayers may cause our loved one to have avoided an occasion of sin while the individual was still on earth! Furthermore, praying for the deceased serves as a way to honour their memory, offer comfort and support to their loved ones, and ask for God's mercy and forgiveness on their behalf. Prayer helps us cope with the grief and loss that comes with death. It provides a sense of peace and hope. Prayer *always* works for good. Talking to God is *never* a waste of time!

Let us make an effort to pray more often. God loves it when we talk to Him about our hopes and needs.
