

Failure and Forgiveness

If we confess our sins,
He is faithful and just
to forgive us our sins,
and to cleanse us
from all unrighteousness.



God is the only one who can forgive us our failures so why should we go to confession to confess our failures to a priest? Why is that necessary? Our Christian Protestant brothers and sisters don't do this!

Dear Friends,

How often have I heard this!

I'm not urging you to do something that I'm not doing myself. Yes, I too, like all priests, go to a priest for confession.

Why do I go to confession? Because that's the way God Himself has set it up. He wants us to go to a priest and confess so we can receive God's forgiveness and absolution.

Our God set it up this way. He wants His pardon and mercy to pass through His son, Jesus. Jesus then passed that authority over to His apostles. He made them the first priests and gave them the power to forgive or retain the sins of others.

If God had wanted us to confess directly to Him, Jesus wouldn't have given His power and authority over to His Apostles to forgive sins. He wouldn't have instituted the Sacrament of Confession. But He did. Why would He do that if that's not the way He wanted it to be?

When we sin, we fail God, we fail the person we have hurt, and we fail ourselves. Confessing one's failures to a priest has been present since the times when the Apostles were still alive. The priest represents God and the person we have hurt. He is there to listen and offer sound advice. It's not the priest who forgives our sins. The priest is human and also sins. Forgiveness comes from our God through the priest. We have *absolute assurance* that we

have been forgiven upon receiving the *sacramental absolution*. God knows that we are human and fail. He loves us so much that He gave us this sacrament so we can remedy our souls and begin fresh once again.

God said, "And I will forgive their wickedness, and *I will never again remember their sins.*" Hebrews 8:12

The sacrament of Reconciliation comes to us directly from our God. It's a gift of pure LOVE to you. Will you accept God's gift?
