

Dear Friends,

God's people are a happy people. We know we are loved. We know we are saved through our Lord's death and resurrection. Our bodies should burst forth in gratitude and happiness! How can we express this?

One way is through music!

As a child, I certainly had the music in me! My mother used to say I was singing before I even learned to talk. I loved to sing along with the choir in church and everywhere else.

"He who sings," said St. Augustine, "prays twice."

Singing adds to our praise and worship of God. Our voices are gifts with which we can make music to the Lord. Sung prayer expresses the joy in our hearts, the happiness we can express because we have Jesus in our lives!

On my tenth birthday, my family procured for me an old guitar. While it didn't have the best sound, I treasured it and learned to play on it. I carried it everywhere and was always ready for an impromptu "jam session" with my friends.

When I was in the refugee camp in Hong Kong, things were quite desolate. I started and directed a choir there. We sang our songs of praise and gratitude to our Lord. It's certainly true that Music calms us and relieves stress. Music improves our health and emotions by making us happy. It brings us together and makes us want to dance!

Remember our first Masses on Zoom? There was no music as we were not allowed to sing. The celebration of the Mass was not the same. Music adds so much life to our worship and makes it more enjoyable.

St. Augustine had this to say about how music in worship increased his religious experience:

"The tears flowed from me when I heard your hymns and canticles, for the sweet singing of your church moved me deeply...The music surged in my ears, truth seeped into my heart, and my feelings of devotion overflowed..."

I find some hymns and songs so beautiful, so moving, that they make me feel like they were either divinely inspired or given to us as a gift straight from the angels!

So, my friends, life is short, and it doesn't always go the way we think it should. However, God is always with us, so let's take our cue from Psalm 33:1-3:

Sing for joy in the LORD, O you righteous ones; Praise is becoming to the upright. Give thanks to the LORD with the lyre; Sing praises to Him with a harp of ten strings. Sing to Him a new song; Play skillfully with a shout of joy!

And thank a choir member today!





KIDS Bulletin – 11th Sunday in Ordinary Time


