Let's make it a practice at the end of each day to look back at all that transpired. Look for at least three things that you are grateful for and thank God for them.


God's Word points to the great importance of gratitude in life: *Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances.*

Pastoral Renewal – You are called. You Matter. You Belong


These simple yet profound words capture the essence of our Pastoral Renewal. Jesus personally calls each one of us to follow Him and to remain by His side, for He deeply loves us.


