

### Dear Friends,

We often think of the time of Lent as being a somber period. Lent is not meant to be a dark season. Like Advent, it's meant to be a time of hope.

Do you know that the word, Lent, means springtime? Our days are getting noticeably longer. It signals the start of the end of Winter and the warmer than seasonal days we've been having, certainly do feel like spring. It's a time when we hope to see more warm sunshine and the start of new buds on our trees. It's a time to look forward to the return of colour to our world with signs of life poking up from the soil, promising the return of crocuses, daffodils, and tulips.

Lent is often a time when we give up things we love. It's a sacrifice that we can make if we choose to. 




