

Note (1)

Total Gross revenues of \$366,850 for the 9-month period ending Sept 30, 2025 represented a \$64,276 increase or 21% over gross revenues recorded to the same period in fiscal 2024. In addition to a \$20,400 increase in general parishioner donations, the parish has also benefited from Bequests totalling \$36,582 and a TIA surplus of 12,083 recorded for the period.

Note: Of the \$36,582 in Bequests, \$10,000 has been patriated to computer upgrades, while the TIA surplus will be apportioned for capital improvements and building repairs as per pre-established arrangement with the Calgary Diocese.

Note (2) – As at September 30, 2025, the parish had collected \$48,277 in TIA donations, exceeding its 2025 target of \$36,194 by \$12,083. Please see note 1 above regarding disposition of this surplus.

St. Gerard's 65thAnniversary Marian Pilgrimage

What is the Marian Pilgrimage?

It is a devotional program centered on Our Lady to foster prayer and spiritual growth.

To participate, host one of the Marian statues as a family or individual for one week in your home and pray the Rosary daily. To increase participation, sign up sheets for the Marian statue are now available at the gathering area, please pick a statue and date of preference.





As we celebrate our 65th Anniversary, our Jubilee Marian Pilgrimage begins this October—the month of the Rosary—and continues through June 2026. Each week, one family or individual from every weekend Mass (5PM, 9AM, and 11AM) is invited to host a Marian statue and pray the Rosary daily at home throughout the week.

Hosting Procedure:

- Due to a poor response for the online sign-up, please use the paper sign-up sheet in the church entrance. Leave your name and phone number.
- Pick up a statue at the Hospitality Table in the church entrance right after Mass.
- Welcome the statue into your home for a week of prayer and reflection.
- Jot down your personal prayer intentions in the included booklet. If it's full, contact the office at 403-253-2251 ext. 3 for a new one.
- Commit to praying the Rosary together as a family each day.
- Before your next Mass, return the statue to the Hospitality Table in the complete prayer bag, which should include: the statue, prayer booklet with intentions, rosary, and pen.
- Share the invitation—encourage your friends to sign up and join in!






Saints Comic Strip
