St. John Lateran Basilica was founded in 324 AD by Emperor Constantine on the site of the ancient Laterani family palace. It is Rome's oldest public church and the Western world's oldest basilica. Consecrated by Pope Sylvester I, it became the Pope's official cathedral and "mother church" of all Catholics. In the 9th century, Pope Sergius III dedicated it to St. John the Baptist and St. John the Evangelist. It has survived fires, earthquakes, and restorations, remaining a key pilgrimage site.
