From the desk of Kathryn Heemskerk, Pastoral Minister:

I have been helping with Sacraments this year as we have tried to catch up from Covid shutdowns and not having a Youth Minister at the moment. If you recall, we had two of them. One thing I often heard during Sacramental preparation was like a two-edged sword: a lament over not having things like Sunday School, VBS, or any other youth focused ministry, and yet wondering why there are no families in our pews? Was it only because we do not have these things? Is having a Sunday School or VBS part of Nurturing Joy or being more welcoming? I want to remind you that these things do not need a youth minister to make them happen. They need <u>your</u> help.

Take for example, the Sunday School: 3 out of 4 parishes had a Sunday School before Covid. I have asked the two that still had leaders to ask if their team would return. While I am waiting for a response to this inquiry, I know that we have no one in Our Lady, Queen of Martyrs or St Cecilia's set up to lead and organize a group to run the Sunday School. If there are 4 to 5 weeks in each month, and we must be at least 2 adults (depending on the number of children), then we need 8 to 10 people to share the job. We could do it with 4 to 6 too, if that was all we had. To run a VBS we need many.... Adult and youth leaders.... It does not take a Youth Minister, but it does take someone with a heart for children who likes to tell stories and do crafts and share the Love of Jesus with children. It does take a bit of commitment too since the Sunday School usually runs the same as the school year. The VBS probably takes a couple of planning meetings, some prep time, and the actual week it is run. Why I am telling you this is that we know this fall there are people wishing we had a Sunday School, but unless several people offer to help, we cannot do it. Do you have a heart for children? Or do you mind heading up a group as the lead contact and person who does the scheduling? If so, we would love to hear from you. Many hands make light work!
