After you have completed the online Baptism forms and done your Baptism formation with Kathryn, you will want to choose a date and location for your baptism. We will be aiming to have baptism in all churches on First Sundays and in the two bigger churches on Second Sundays. This will also help the Deacons with their own schedules.

Two reminders.... don't wait! Let's bring our children as soon as we can to the waters of Baptism. It is here that God washes away original sin, and your child not only becomes a child of God, but also a member of the parish community.

Second, once you have been baptized don't lose that certificate! You will be asked to offer copies for kindergarten, for future sacraments, and sometimes as proof in other diocese to participate in their sacraments, for example as Godparents.

ST VINCENT DE PAUL UPDATE--SIMCOE/WATERFORD/ DELHI

During the past month, in the Simcoe/Waterford/Delhi area, we gave a three day supply of groceries and \$500.00 in food store gift cards, from our pantries, to 105 families, having a total of 264 adults and children. The Soup Kitchen reopened on October 13th and will run through till mid April, 2023 in the Knights of Columbus Hall, on Kent Street, in Simcoe. The Simcoe /Waterford Knights Of Columbus has given us rent and utilities free use of the hall for 38 years, and for this, we are indeed truly blessed and thankful for their generosity.

The donations for the month of October were \$1027.00 from Our Lady Queen of Martyrs, \$1907.00 from St. Bernard's and \$2407.00 from St Mary's. In addition during October, we received Thanksgiving donations from the students, staff and parents of St Joseph's School, Ecole Ste Marie and Holy Trinity High School.
