# 3rd Sunday of Lent—March 12, 2023



#### Dear Friends:

Pastor
The Lenten observances are expected to foster within us a conversion of heart. It means a complete change (metanoia) or U-turn from our old ways of sin to God our Creator in response to his love. This is the desire of God for every one of us. The penitential nature of the season of Lent creates this aware-

ness in us so that we may celebrate the joy of resurrection with a worthy and acceptable heart before the Lord. It is from the heart that various thoughts and desires have their root. Jesus Christ said, "do you not know that whatever enters the mouth goes into the stomach, and then out of the body? But what comes out of the mouth comes from the heart, and that is what makes a person unclean" (Matthew 15:11-12). Likewise, according to Prophet Joel, "Yahweh says, yet even now, return to me with your whole heart, with fasting, weeping and mourning. Rend your heart, not your garment" (Joel 2:12-13). It is about inner conversion which goes beyond the outward works of penance. Our almsgiving, prayers, and fasting must bring the needed change in our hearts. We are called to see Christ in those who benefit from our generosity without nursing any prejudice in our hearts; our prayers receive the strength to rise to God in a heart free of hatred or grudges; and fasting is to be done with a heart of forgiveness. In our reflection during this season, let us keep in mind that God desires a pure heart for his dwelling. God will make this possible with the grace of the Holy Spirit in us.

Next weekend is our Parish Mission. It will be led by Fr Peter Keller, the Vice Rector of St Peter's Seminary, London. We are all encouraged to see it as an important spiritual journey together within our community of faith. We shall learn together through the grace of the Holy Spirit to see ourselves as God's gifts to one another building up the unity of God's children. Everyone has a role to play because we all have various gifts of the Holy Spirit. Therefore, let us find time to attend the evening sessions of Sunday, Monday and Wednesday. We can find details in the bulletin. May the Spirit of God grant us the desire for a conversion of heart and fill us with the joy of resurrection. Amen.

### **OUR FASCINATING FAITH—The Scrutinies**


This Sunday, if your parish is blessed with catechumens (now called "elect" during Lent) who are preparing for baptism at the Easter Vigil, you will likely celebrate with them the first of three scrutinies. These are rites integral to final Lenten preparations made by the elect, and they are celebrated on three successive

Sundays, starting with the Third Sunday of Lent. The Church tells us that the scrutinies are meant to uncover and heal all that is weak and sinful in the lives of the elect. During the week leading up to each celebration, the elect engage in prayerful preparation involving deep reflection on their own lives and the new life to which they are called. The rites themselves use a special form of intercessions specifically directed to the lives of the elect, and include a prayer of exorcism.

It is essential that these rites be celebrated in the midst of the community, so that the elect experience the support of the parish members on this profound journey of faith. But it is equally important that the parish members witness the growing faith of the elect so they may be inspired by it for their Lenten journey of reflection on their own baptism in preparation for Easter.
