

Last month, in the Simcoe/Waterford/Delhi area, we gave a three day supply of groceries and \$1225.00 in food store gift cards, to 133 families, having a total of 389 adults and children. The Community Meals, [formally known as the Soup Kitchen], closed for the season on April 20<sup>th</sup>, after serving 3728 full course meals, since mid October 2022. This will give us time to search for a new home, as the Knights of Columbus have sold the building on Kent St. after giving us over 38 years of free rent and utilities, in which to operate this mission

The collection for the month of July was \$594.00 at St Bernard's, \$870.00 at Our Lady Queen of Martyrs, and \$1307.00 at St Mary's. Our volunteers will be available after Mass on August 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> to receive your kind donations to continue our support to our Neighbours In Need.
