Dear Friend:

Next week, some of our children will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation as they complete their Sacraments of Initiation. The three Sacraments of initiation are Baptism, Holy Eucharist and Confirmation. We congratulate them and their families for their openness to receive the empowerment of the Holy Spirit into their life. We encourage them to nurture the gifts that God gives to them through prayer and worship, meditating on the word of God for guidance and strength on their journey of faith. As a community of faith, we thank God for his generous gift to his faithful as we rejoice with these young people. This is to affirm that our people are listened to, and they are being heard. This is in accordance with the desire of Bishop Fabbro for us to become a mission-oriented church forming disciples of Jesus. Your prayer for the council has been very helpful at our planning meetings as we continue to seek the direction of the Holy Spirit. We thank you for your prayers. May the Lord increase our faith and grant us fulfilment in the service of his holy name. Amen.

*This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it. Psalm 118:24*

So often, though, we judge a day in terms of what we have or have not done rather than of what Christ has already done. So how should we spend Lent.
