

+ My dear parish family:

I hope you all had a wonderful Easter celebration with your family and friends. It was fantastic to see the great attendance at our many beautiful Holy Week liturgies.

On the Monday night after Palm Sunday, Father Carlos, Father Vincent, and I renewed our priestly ordination vows together with Cardinal Tobin and all the priests of our archdiocese during the Chrism Mass held in our Sacred Heart Cathedral in Newark. Several parishioners joined us. I hope that many more will come next year.

Then on Thursday morning, Bishop John Flesey gathered all of us priests from Bergen County for his final Holy Thursday morning reflection. Some of you may know him as the Pastor of our neighboring parish of Most Blessed Sacrament in Franklin Lakes. He has been an inspiration to me all throughout the 17 years of my priesthood. I thought you might like to read this poem he wrote entitled *Ordination*:

Go lie upon the marble floor And hear the Spirit's song A Litany of Saints proclaimed Through ages all along

Go kneel beneath the Bishop's hands Imposed with silent blush. An intimate expression Of the Spirit's loving touch.

> Go forth with joy And give your life Upon the altar of your days.

Go live the Eucharistic Mystery And set the world ablaze.

This award-winning movie is a beautiful representation of the mystical life of St. Maria Faustina, who became the "Apostle of Divine Mercy". It tells the story of her mystical experiences as a nun living in a convent in Poland in the early 20th century. It is to her that Jesus appeared and commanded that she be his instrument for promoting devotion to his Divine Mercy, and that the Feast of Divine Mercy be established and celebrated on the Sunday after Easter.

May we rejoice in the mercy that God shows us, and may our simple prayer this week be "Jesus, I trust in you."

**Thank You for giving to CRS Rice Bowl:** This Lent you have become companions on the journey for our neighbors most in need. Now it's time to put


your good work into action by returning your full rice bowl. There will be collection baskets in the Narthex or bring them to the Parish Office. May God Bless you for your kindness to those in need!
