

My dear friends at St. Elizabeth's

In my homily last week, I suggested that Advent this year would be different than in prior years because of the struggles we all face during the current pandemic. I know that for me the period between Thanksgiving and Christmas is usually an exciting time of the year filled with the hustle and bustle of shopping at the malls, going to office parties, and family get-togethers. It always seemed that my time was consumed by lists of things to organize and do, cards to be mailed, food to be eaten, and of course, the diet to be neglected.



It is so easy for all of us, myself included, to get caught up in the seasonal tasks and preparations that we forget to stop and reflect on the "reason for the season;" it is not about getting ready for Christmas; it is about getting ready for CHRIST. It is about the light of God's saving grace entering our hearts. It is about preparing the way of the Lord! This year, we have a unique opportunity to pause, to step back a bit, and to nourish our spiritual life. There is much we can do to prepare for the coming of Jesus.

Perhaps we can consider Advent this year as a season of Christian "road works," as an opportunity for all of us to put on our hardhats and shine our spiritual flashlights into the darkness to find and straighten out those obstacles and dangers that hinder our preparation for the coming of Jesus. It could mean more prayer time on our knees, perhaps time before the Blessed Sacrament, or the opportunity to fill-in the valleys of our lives through a good confession. It could be picking up the phone and calling a lonely friend or family member or supporting a local charity or food pantry.

This year we are invited to nourish our spiritual life as we journey through Advent towards Christmas. On Tuesday, December 15 at 9:30am and again at 7:30pm, Fr. Ashley Harrington will be at St. Elizabeth's to offer us a reflection titled, *Let's Journey Together This Advent*. The content will be the same in the morning and evening sessions and will be available in the Church and livestreamed. I am looking forward to being inspired by Fr. Ashley and journeying with you!!

As we journey together through Advent toward Christmas, I am reminded of another journey taken 2,000 years ago from Nazareth to Bethlehem by a man named Joseph and a woman called Mary, who was ready to give birth. The woman, whom the Angel Gabriel hailed as full of grace, was carrying God's amazing grace within her womb. His amazing grace, God's gift to the world, was a baby boy born in a cave in Bethlehem. This is the Christmas miracle. God so loved us that He sent His only begotten Son, who was later crucified on a cross to redeem us from sin, and who will come again at the end of time as the King of Glory.

God's grace, Emmanuel - which means "God is with us" - journeyed with Joseph and Mary in their difficult trek to Bethlehem. He journeys with you and me as we struggle through our current circumstances. This Advent let us be prepared to receive the light of God's saving grace, Jesus Christ. This is God's gift to us. O Come, O Come Emmanuel!!



Statement of the Catholic Bishops of New Jersey on the Reproductive Freedom Act: The Catholic Church believes and teaches that all human life is sacred from conception to natural death. For that reason, we, the Bishops of each of the dioceses in New Jersey, join in voicing the strongest possible opposition to the "Reproductive Freedom Act."

Without minimizing other serious threats to human life and dignity evident in contemporary American society, the Catholic Church consistently maintains that "the threat of abortion remains our preeminent priority because it directly attacks life itself, because it takes place within the sanctuary of the family, and because of the number of lives destroyed" (USCCB, Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship, "Introductory Letter," 2020). As the Catholic Bishops of New Jersey, we urge all Catholics and people of good will to reject this proposed legislative initiative in our state and to contact your State legislators to vigorously express opposition to its passage.
