Last week we celebrated Baptism of the Lord. In His own baptism, Jesus, reveals to us His true identity, that He is the Son of God and the Trinitarian God: the Father (voice from Heaven), the Son (Jesus Christ), and the Holy Spirit (the dove). With His baptism, Jesus also instituted the Sacrament of Baptism for us.

There are two effects of baptism: first, the original sins that all human persons carry and all the other sins the individual may have committed in their lifetime before baptism are wiped away. Second, the person who is baptized receives an indelible mark, making the person an adopted child of God the Father.

This indelible mark is the key to understanding this beautiful sacrament. As I said in last week's homily, the baptism that St. John proclaimed was baptism of repentance, the baptism of recognizing our sins and turning away from them. However, Jesus had no need for



this baptism because He was sinless. However, Jesus adds another dimension to the baptism by St. John. By being baptized and revealing to the world that He is God the Son, He showed that those who are baptized in His baptism are now united to that reality of Jesus as the son of God. This is the indelible mark. In our baptism, we are united to the Sonship of Jesus Christ, and we are transformed into children of God. Like Jesus, we can now truly call God our Father! The fruit of this indelible mark is the wiping away of our sins. Since we are not just mere human creatures, but also beloved children of God like Jesus, who is sinless, we become sinless as well.

However, just because we are sinless, does not mean we are not capable of sinning. We are still able to sin, and we do still sin. But that is not who we are. It goes against our nature to sin. If humanity was meant to sin, then sinning would not be a problem. However, as beloved children of God, it is unnatural and distorted to sin. How do we reconcile these two realities of being beloved children of God and still being capable of sinning?

The Sacrament of Reconciliation, is the remedy that God give us. Growing up, I really did not like going to confession, because it always made me recognize how "bad" I was. However, over time, I realized confession is not about saying how bad I am, but saying how much better I want to be. It is accepting the identity given to us at our baptisms and telling God that "I want to live my life as your beloved child." In return God the Father does not call us to focus on the sins we committed, but reminds us that, no matter what we think of ourselves, no matter the sins, we will remain His beloved children, and nothing will change that.

Adrienne Von Speyer, one of my favorite authors and a mystic, wrote in her book *Confession* that we approach Confession just like Jesus Christ approaches the Father. He is utterly open, vulnerable, revealing everything, and offering everything He has to the Father. In Confession, we approach the Father as His Son as did. We are utterly open, vulnerable, revealing everything, and offering everything, even our sins, to the Father. And He will say to us "You are my beloved children, with you I am well pleased."






