Dear friends,

Happy Easter! We are in the Easter Season, the most important season of the Church. Jesus is risen!



I am so grateful God for allowing us to celebrate Easter together this year. I have to admit that I was a little sad last year after celebrating all Easter Masses. I sat in Church alone. We celebrated Easter without no one in Church. Everything was live streamed. But I had some consolation that Easter afternoon. When we the priests, were surprised by a caravan of some parishioners passing by the rectory and using their horns to say hello to us and screaming “Happy Easter, Father!” I had tears running down my face. I was reminded that hope is not lost, that God is always present even in difficult times, that Jesus is risen!

As we continue celebrating this Easter Season, I am looking forward to some future events that I will be leading. We will be celebrating our Year of St. Joseph and the Month of May in a very special way. Monday to Friday, I will be leading the Rosary at 7pm during the Month of May. This event will be in person and livestreamed. You are invited to get closer to our Blessed Mother and to pray for all the intentions we have in our hearts. Perhaps, if we consecrate this Month of May in a very special way, we will be able to receive an answer to our petitions. Although the Month of May is dedicated to our Blessed Mother, on Wednesdays, we will be praying the Mysteries of St. Joseph. These are some new mysteries of the Rosary I just learned. There is also a “Hail Mary” for St. Joseph we will be reciting on Wednesdays.

In the month of June, we will celebrate Corpus Cristi, the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of the Lord in the Eucharist. We will display special flower arrangements in the altar, and after the 12 noon Mass, we will have a special procession outside of the Church with the Blessed Sacrament at the head of the procession. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed until 3pm in Church, and the day will conclude with Benediction.

Finally, I want to share with you the Mysteries of St. Joseph Rosary or “Josephian Rosary” with St. Joseph’s “Hail Mary.”

Mysteries of the St. Joseph Rosary

1. Betrothal to Mary (Mt 1:18)
2. Annunciation to Joseph (Mt 1:19-21)
3. Birth and Naming of Jesus (Mt 1:22-25)
4. Flight into Egypt (Mt 2:13-15)
5. Hidden Life at Nazareth (Mt 2:23; Lk 2:51-52)

St. Joseph’s “Hail Mary:”

Joseph, son of David, and husband of Mary; we honor you, guardian of the Redeemer, and we adore the child you named Jesus. Saint Joseph, patron of the universal church, pray for us, that like you we may live totally dedicated to the interests of the Savior. Amen.

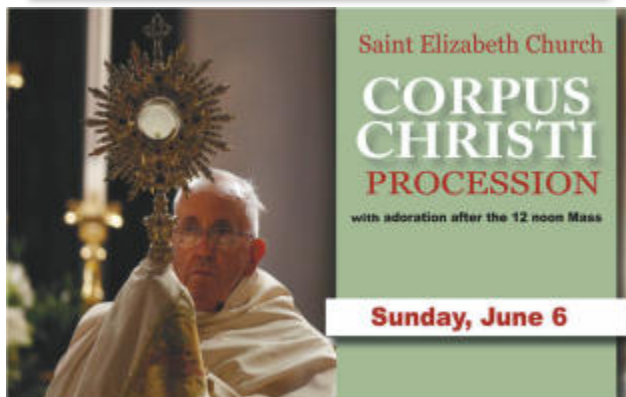

R.C.I.A. - Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is designed to welcome adults into our Catholic faith. Preparation is a year-long ongoing process culminating at the Easter Vigil Mass. The goal is to receive the Sacraments of Baptism (for non-Christians), Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. IS RCIA FOR YOU or SOMEONE YOU KNOW? Do you know someone or are you someone who is interested in becoming Catholic? Are you Catholic but have not yet received all of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist)? The RCIA is a process of prayer, reflection, and learning that allows for the continual discernment of God's will in our lives. Candidates include: Non-baptized adults who wish to enter the Catholic Church, baptized adult Christians of another denomination (i.e. Lutheran, Anglican, Presbyterian) who wish to continue their Christian faith in the Catholic Church, adult baptized Catholics who have not completed the Sacraments of Initiation (Holy Communion and/or Confirmation) and wish to do so. 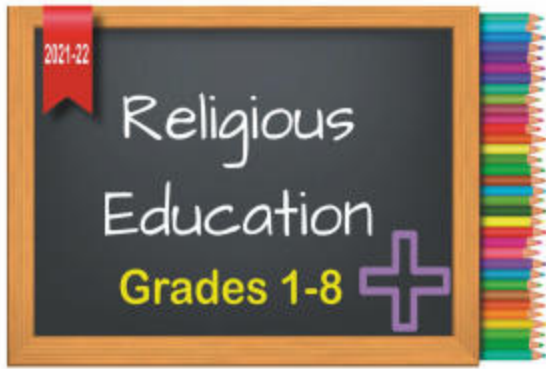
