We will be celebrating our Year of St. Joseph and the Month of May in a very special way. Monday to Friday, I will be leading the Rosary at 7pm during the Month of May. This event will be in person and livestreamed. You are invited to get closer to our Blessed Mother and to pray for all the intentions we have in our hearts. Perhaps, if we consecrate this Month of May in a very special way, we will be able to receive an answer to our petitions. Although the Month of May is dedicated to our Blessed Mother, on Wednesdays, we will be praying the Mysteries of St. Joseph. These are some new mysteries of the Rosary I just learned. There is also a "Hail Mary" for St. Joseph we will be reciting on Wednesdays.

In the month of June, we will celebrate Corpus Cristi, the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of the Lord in the Eucharist. We will display special flower arrangements in the altar, and after the 12 noon Mass, we will have a special procession outside of the Church with the Blessed Sacrament at the head of the procession. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed until 3pm in Church, and the day will conclude with Benediction.

- 5. Hidden Life at Nazareth (Mt 2:23; Lk 2:51-52)





The goal is to receive the Sacraments of Baptism (for non-Christians), Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. IS RCIA FOR YOU or SOMEONE YOU KNOW? Do you know someone or are you someone who is interested in becoming Catholic? Are you Catholic but have not yet received all of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist)? The RCIA is a process of prayer, reflection, and learning that allows for the continual discernment of God's will in our lives. Candidates include: Non-baptized adults who wish to enter the Catholic Church, baptized adult Christians of another denomination (i.e. Lutheran, Anglican, Presbyterian) who wish to continue their Christian faith in the Catholic Church, adult baptized Catholics who have not completed he Sacraments of Initiation (Holy Communion and/or Confirmation) and wish to do so. 




