One of the greatest gifts I received from my first few years of seminary was the desire to love God. I realized how deep and beautiful our faith was, and I truly began to love the Church. Through this experience, my desire to love God started to grow. However, even though I had the desire to love Him, I did not know how. I worked on my virtues, read more spiritual readings, and spent more time on my prayers, but I was still not sure that I was loving God. However, in the seminary a spiritual director told me that salvation is always communal. We cannot be saved by ourselves and that there are others around us. This led me to realize that I have to love others if I want to love God.



The Gospel from the sixth Sunday of Easter reveals to us this truth: If you want to remain in Christ's love, you have to keep His commandment "to Love one another as

I love you." Christ, Himself, remains in God the Father's love by loving others. This is how we love God. Just as the Father gives Himself fully to the Son, and the Son gives Himself fully to us, love is always going outwards; love is always aimed at others.

When we surrender our entire being to God the Father, just as Jesus did on the cross -"Father, into your hands I commend my spirit"- the Father sends us out to others. God takes our love for Him and transforms it into love of another, always aiming at the good of others.





Knights of Columbus Cornhole Tournament May 19




