DO YOU KNOW ABOUT THE FIRST SATURDAY DEVOTION TO THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY?

On July 13, 1917, Our Lady told the three children of Fatima that God desired to establish devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary as a way to save souls from hell.

In Pontevedra, Spain, on Dec. 10, 1925, Our Lady and the Christ Child appeared to Sister Lucia - one of the children - asking for reparation for the offenses and blasphemies spoken against Mary's Immaculate Heart. Mary asked the faithful, on the first Saturday of five consecutive months to:

- · "confess their sins,
- receive Holy Communion,
- · recite five decades of the Rosary,
- and keep me company for 15 minutes while meditating on the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary.
- with the intention of making reparation to me.

Mary promised that she will assist at the moment of death with all graces necessary for salvation to all who make this devotion. The Christ Child stressed that we should make this devotion not once, but over and over again.

Jesus subsequently appeared to Sister Lucia, encouraging her to spread this devotion, and explained there are five kinds of offenses and blasphemies spoken against the Immaculate Heart of Mary:

- · Against her Immaculate Conception
- Against her perpetual virginity
- · Against her Divine maternity and refusal to accept her as the Mother of mankind
- By those who try publicly to implant in the hearts of children an indifference, contempt, and even hate for the Immaculate Mother.
- · By those who insult her directly in her sacred images

At each of Our Lady's six appearances in 1917, she requested the rosary be prayed every day to obtain peace. Our Lady of Fatima's messages to the world remain relevant, timely and urgent to this day!




