Last week's second reading from St. Paul's letter to the Ephesians is one of the most difficult passages on which to preach. "Wives should be subordinate to their husbands as to the Lord." It sounds like St. Paul is belittling women, and their role in the family. It is always interesting to see the reactions of people when this passage is read. Some get nervous, some get annoyed, some laugh, and some get angry. This teaching of St. Paul might be harder for us to accept in our time than it was for Jesus's followers to accept the teaching about the Eucharist: "This saying is hard, who can accept it?"

However, I think there is a proper way of understanding this passage. St. Paul speaks of the marital relationship "in reference to Christ and the Church." He sees that marriage should be a reflection of the love between Christ and the Church. And this love is love of surrendering - to love the other so perfectly that one is not thinking about oneself but only the other.

The word "subordinate" in Greek is "hupotasso." "Hupo" means "under" and "tasso" means "to arrange." In this relationship of Christ and His Church, Jesus is the head and the Church is the body, and the Body is rightfully "arranged under" the head. However, to be a fully alive person, the head must have the body. This is the intimate relationship that St. Paul envisions in marriage: the love of the husband who only seeks the contentment of his wife to the point that he forgets himself, and the love of the wife who receives that love and returns it fully to her husband to the point that she forgets herself. In this act of surrendering to each other, the two are not separate people anymore, but they become one flesh.

Husbands, this does not mean that you are superior to your wives. Rather you should do everything in your power to bring them happiness. Wives, this does not mean that the teachings are outdated or only apply to those in the past. It is a strong reminder to all of us that love, fundamentally, does not seek what is good for oneself, but that love is fulfilled in our relationship with God and his Church.

DO YOU KNOW ABOUT THE FIRST FRIDAY DEVOTION TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS?

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is an ancient tradition in the Church. It was St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, however, who made this devotion widespread. In 1675, during the octave of the Feast of Corpus Christi, Our Lord appeared to her and said:

"Behold this heart which, notwithstanding the burning love for men with which it is consumed and exhausted, meets with no other return from most Christians than sacrilege, contempt, indifference and ingratitude, even in the sacrament of my love [the Eucharist]. But what pierces my heart most deeply is that I am subjected to these insults by persons especially consecrated to my service."

To those who show him love and who make reparation for sins, however, Our Lord made a pledge:

"I promise you in the unfathomable mercy of my heart that my omnipotent love will procure the grace of final penitence for all those who receive Communion on nine successive first Fridays of the month; they will not die in my disfavor, or without having received the sacraments, since my divine heart will be their sure refuge in the last moments of their life."

The great promise of the Sacred Heart is most consoling: the grace of final perseverance and the joy of having Jesus' heart as our sure refuge and infinite ocean of mercy in our last hour.

To gain this grace, we must:

- Receive Holy Communion on nine consecutive First Fridays.
- Have the intention of honoring the Sacred Heart of Jesus and reaching final perseverance.
- Offer each Holy Communion as an act of atonement for offenses against the Blessed Sacrament

St. Paul's Church offers Eucharistic Adoration on the First Friday of every month from 7:00 PM-8:00 PM.

R.C.I.A.— Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is designed to welcome adults into our Catholic faith. Preparation is a year-long ongoing process culminating at the Easter Vigil Mass. The goal is to receive the Sacraments of Baptism (for non-Christians), Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. IS RCIA FOR YOU or SOME-ONE YOU KNOW? Do you know someone or are you someone who is interested in becoming Catholic? Are you Catholic but have not yet received all of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist)? The RCIA is a process of prayer, reflection, and learning that allows for the continual discernment of God's will in our lives. Candidates include: Non-baptized adults who wish to enter the Catholic Church, baptized adult Christians of another denomination (i.e. Lutheran, Anglican, Presbyterian) who wish to continue their Christian faith in the Catholic Church, adult baptized Catholics who have not completed he Sacraments of Initiation (Holy




