When I decided to enter the seminary, I was not at all prepared to become a priest. I was struggling with the thought of being a priest, and all the things I'd have to give up. I would not have a "normal" life in the eyes of the world. However, whenever I imagined myself not entering the seminary, there was a great feeling of regret. This feeling did not leave me for a while. So, I decided to seriously try out the seminary for one year. That first year, my vocation to the priesthood did not grow; I was still uncertain, still full of doubt. However, my love for Christ and the Church grew immensely. I have never had great zeal or motivation to pursue anything in my life, but that first year of seminary ignited my heart so much that I just wanted to keep going. I wanted to learn more about the Church and all its beauty. I wanted to learn more about my faith, about holiness, about Jesus Christ.



The seminary is not a factory that pumps out priests. It is a place that forms men to be disciples on fire for the Lord. Only after the initial formation can these men know if they are called to serve the Lord as priests or by other vocations. St. Andrew's College Seminary is having a "Come and See" night on Wednesday, Oct 27th. There will be a tour of the seminary, along with Mass and dinner, and a Q&A session. If any high school boys are interested not just in becoming a priest, but also interested in being on fire for the Lord, please check the college seminary out! It is a wonderful place to learn and grow in the faith.

To the parents: Please, be open to all vocations for your children! Expose them to different vocations within the Church and support your children by being the instrument of the Holy Spirit! So many vocations to the priesthood and religious life fade away because the family did not support them. Please, be the mediator of God's grace, not the obstacle.

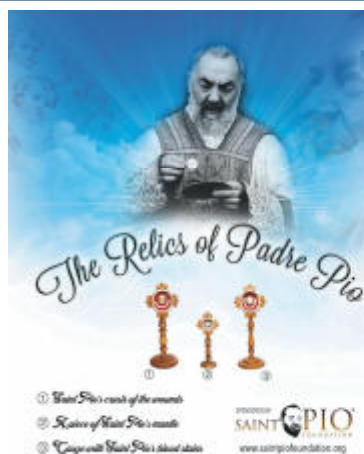
