I have never had great zeal or motivation to pursue anything in my life, but that first year of seminary ignited my heart so much that I just wanted to keep going. I wanted to learn more about the Church and all its beauty. I wanted to learn more about my faith, about holiness, about Jesus Christ.



The seminary is not a factory that pumps out priests. It is a place that forms men to be disciples on fire for the Lord. Only after the initial formation can these men know if they are called to serve the Lord as priests or by other vocations. If any high school boys are interested not just in becoming a priest, but also interested in being on fire for the Lord, please check the college seminary out! To the parents: Please, be open to all vocations for your children! Expose them to different vocations within the Church and support your children by being the instrument of the Holy Spirit! So many vocations to the priesthood and religious life fade away because the family did not support them. Please, be the mediator of God's grace, not the obstacle.


