

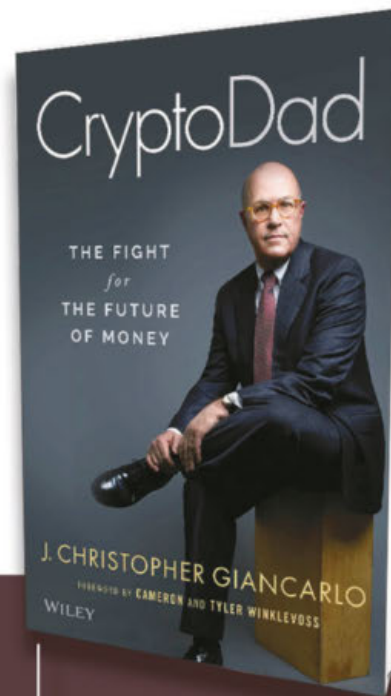

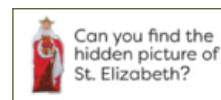

Last week I mentioned the discernment of spirits by St. Ignatius of Loyola to help us recognize our Lord's voice and to follow Him. In order to be properly aware of our Lord's will, understand it, and take necessary action, St. Ignatius created 14 rules for discerning. I will not go over all of the 14 rules because that would need more space, but I would like to focus on rules 3 and 4. These two rules define and show what spiritual consolation and spiritual desolation looks like. I wanted to focus on these two rules because consolation allows us to recognize God's inner working in our lives, while desolation allows us to know what it means to live without God in our lives.

Rule 3 focuses on spiritual consolation. Consolation is when some interior movement occurs in the soul, through which the soul comes to be inflamed with love of its Creator and Lord, and consequently when it can love no created thing on the face of the earth in itself, but only in the Creator of them all. Likewise, it sheds tears that move to love of its Lord, whether out of sorrow for one's sins or for the passion of Christ our Lord or because of other things directly ordered to His service and praise. Finally, consolation is every increase of hope, faith, and charity, and all interior joy that calls and attracts to heavenly things and to the salvation of one's soul, quieting it and giving it peace in its Creator and Lord.

Rule 4 focuses on spiritual desolation. Desolation is the opposite of the third rule. It is the darkness of soul, disturbance in it, movement to low and earthly things, disquiet resulting from various agitations and temptations, moving to lack of confidence, without hope, without love, finding oneself totally slothful, tepid, and sad, as if separated from one's Creator and Lord. For just as consolation is contrary to desolation, in the same way the thoughts that come from consolation are contrary to the thoughts that come from desolation.

There are 12 other rules, but I think if we learn to recognize these two rules, it will greatly benefit our spiritual life.

R.C.I.A. Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is designed to welcome adults into our Catholic faith. Preparation is a yearlong ongoing process culminating at the Easter Vigil Mass. The goal is to receive the Sacraments of Baptism (for non Christians), Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. IS RCIA FOR YOU or SOMEONE YOU KNOW? Do you know someone or are you someone who is interested in becoming Catholic? Are you Catholic but have not yet received all of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist)? The RCIA is a process of prayer, reflection, and learning that allows for the continual discernment of God's will in our lives. Candidates include: Nonbaptized adults who wish to enter the Catholic Church, baptized adult Christians of another denomination (i.e. Lutheran, Anglican, Presbyterian) who wish to continue their Christian faith in the Catholic Church, adult baptized Catholics who have not completed the Sacraments of Initiation (Holy Communion and/or Confirmation) and wish to do so. 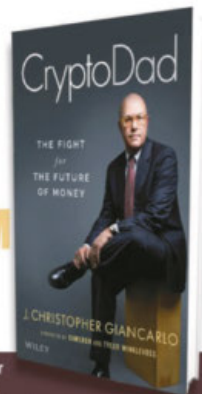

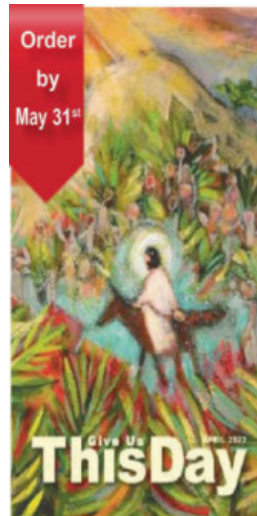
