



Last week was the Solemnity of Corpus Christ, feast where the Church focuses on the true presence of Jesus Christ especially in the Eucharist. I remember giving a little explanation to our second graders who were preparing for first communion. I said that the Eucharist is TRULY Jesus Christ and one of the children screamed "Are we cannibals, if we are eating Jesus Christ!?" It sounds silly at first, since we are obviously not cannibals, but it is an important question to answer. Often, we overlook the question of the true presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, and we simply explain to our children that it is only a symbol. However, this completely takes away the essential and foundational belief of the Catholic Church! According to the PEW research in 2019, over 70% of Catholics in the United States believed that the Eucharist was only a symbol of Jesus Christ. Truly disturbing!


To properly understand and appreciate more the mystery of the Eucharist, I would like to give a brief explanation of "Transbustantiation," a process in which the bread

and wine turns into the body and blood of Our Lord. First, I think its proper to know the philosophical concept of "substance" and "accidents". Substance derives from Greek word "Ousia," meaning being or existence. It refers to what a thing is in it of itself. Accidents derives from Greek word "Sunbaino," meaning to go with. It refers to certain aspects that exists within the substance. For example, Honey is our family pet. Her substance is that she is a dog. Honey is in it of herself a dog. The accidents of Honey is that she has curly fur, little brownish and white in color, and she is about 15lbs. There are other dogs who have different accidents than Honey but nevertheless they all share the substance of being dogs.

Now jumping to the Eucharist. Before the words of consecration, the bread and the wine are still bread and wine in their substance and it has all the accidents of bread and wine. The bread is made out flour, unleavened, little crumbly and circular, and the wine is red, little sweet, and it has alcohol. However, through the words of consecration, even though the ACCIDENTS remain the same, the SUBSTANCE of the bread and wine is transformed (TransSubstantiation). It may seem to be the same bread and wine, but now it is Jesus Christ in it of Himself! And this is why we are precisely able to eat our Lord. Because our Lord is manifesting His Divine Self in the accidents of bread and wine, something we can consume!

It is important to note that the true appreciation of the Eucharist does not arise from theological knowledge but loving relationship with the Lord. However, there is a huge difference in between saying that Jesus is truly here, and it is like Jesus is here. Let us never belittle the greatest gift Our Lord has given us to a mere symbol.




