



Dr. Geetha Yeruva, founder/president of FCN, is very happy to be visiting us and will share details about the foundation's mission work in the interior villages of India. FCN sponsors 2000 children and college students. They have built several schools, boarding homes, a community health center and two homes for the elderly. 2000 children born with cleft lips and cleft palates have been helped through free corrective surgeries over the past 8 years. 


