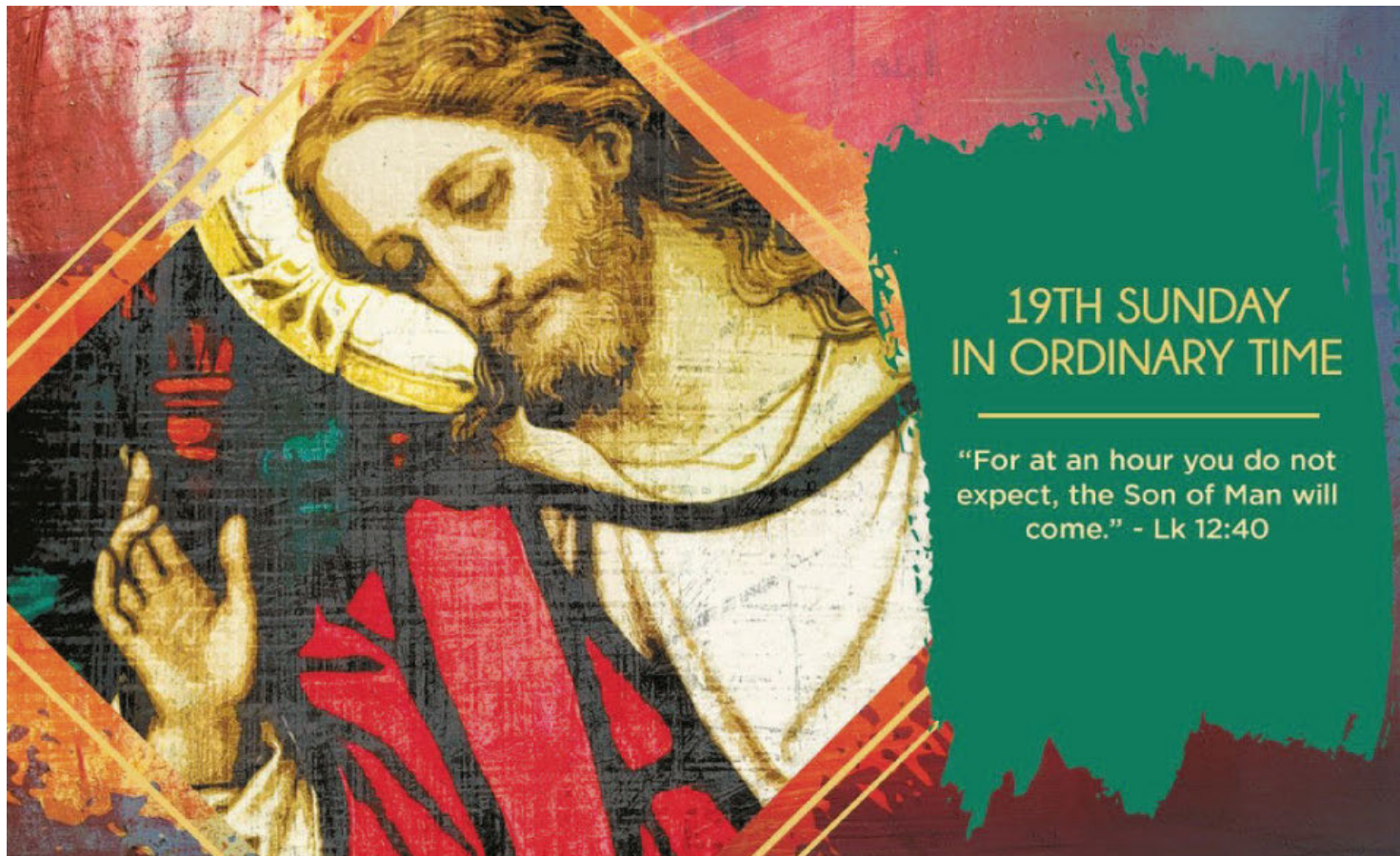

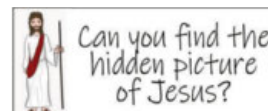

We welcome parent volunteers to help with our activities also, so please let us know!

In our Gospel reading last week from Luke, we heard the parable of The Rich Fool - a man with a plentiful harvest who was only concerned with building larger barns for himself and living a comfortable life. It was not an easy homily for me to write, in part because the main theme is to avoid the idolatry of greed and I am constantly blown away by your generosity. In over 60 different ministries, St. E parishioners can be found serving the hungry in soup kitchens, delivering food to food pantries, donating essential items to pregnancy resource centers, volunteering at camps for our special friends, visiting the homebound, and the list goes on!

Your generosity and thoughtfulness inspire me in my own diaconal ministry and give me the strength and encouragement I need. Special Collection this weekend, August 6/7, for the Pastoral Solidarity Fund for the Church in Africa. While the Church in Africa is growing, many still lack access to basic resources and pastoral care, and are challenged by high rates of poverty and unemployment, illiteracy, and poor education. The Solidarity Fund supports pastoral projects that strengthen faith and foster everlasting peace.

Mission Co-Op Collection and Speaker on August 20/21: Each summer, the Mission Office of our archdiocese invites a missionary group to share information about their mission work. Next weekend, August 20-21, we will have a guest speaker at all the Masses who will talk about the annual mission appeal. Foundation for Children in Need is a Catholic lay organization based in Arlington Heights, IL. Dr. Geetha Yeruva, founder/president of FCN, is very happy to be visiting us and will share details about the foundation's mission work in the interior villages of India. FCN sponsors 2000 children and college students. They have built several schools, boarding homes, a community health center and two homes for the elderly. 2000 children born with cleft lips and cleft palates have been helped through free corrective surgeries over the past 8 years. 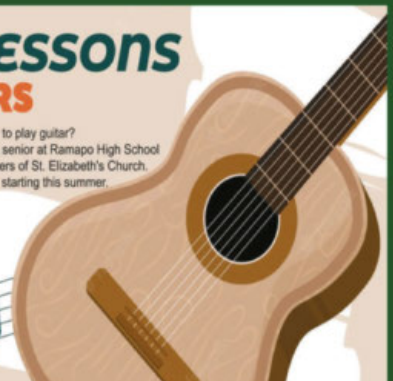

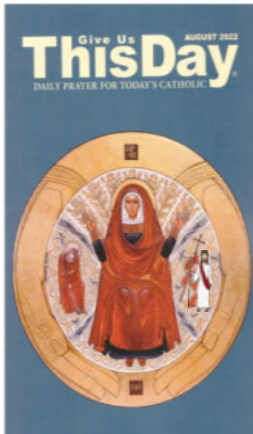
