

Hello dear friends in Christ,

As we enter the second week of Advent in this new liturgical year, I pray that you are making some quiet time for the Lord in prayer. In this wonderful season of preparation and waiting, we are called to turn away from the things of the world and to turn our attention to the things of heaven. This is no easy task, especially with the many distractions we face every day: the World Cup, football and basketball games, Christmas shopping, our phones, and all of the other activities we find ourselves so busy with. If we let these distractions and pleasures take over our lives, we will miss the call of our Lord to, "Stay Awake!"

Last week in my homily, I talked about the work of St. Vincent Ferrer, a Dominican priest born in the 1300's who preached powerfully about the Second Coming of our Lord and of our need to prepare. They say he con-

verted thousands of people to the faith through his preaching. Pope Pius II called him "the Angel of the Apocalypse, flying through the heavens to announce the day of the Last Judgment, to evangelize the inhabitants of the earth." St. Vincent cautioned, "On that day it will be better to be a sheep of Jesus Christ than to have been a pope, or king, or emperor." I shared with you the five virtues St. Vincent detailed to help us stay awake for the Lord and to distinguish the sheep from the goats:

- ➤ Simple innocence is when a person "lives simply, nor hurts anyone in his heart, by hating, nor by defaming in speech, nor striking with hands, nor by stealing. Such a life is called simple innocence, which makes a man a sheep of Christ."
- ➤ Ample mercy means distributing our God-given temporal and spiritual gifts to the needy "because among all the animals a sheep is the most beneficial of animals."
- > Steadfast patience takes different forms, such as when someone "suffering from injuries inflicted or spoken to him does not want to concern himself with taking revenge. Rather he loves everyone in general, and prays for them all."
- True obedience means ordering all of our thoughts, words, and actions according to God's will, not ours, just as sheep are so obedient that a child with a staff "can easily guide 30 or 40 sheep."
- ➤ Worthy penance "is necessary, by sorrowing for our sins and proposing not to relapse, confessing, and making satisfaction. And in this way penance makes a man a sheep of Christ."

There are so many ways to help us put these virtues into practice here at St. Elizabeth's! Through your generosity, our Knights of Columbus are able to provide winter coats for children in need and the Advent Giving Tree project provides wonderful Christmas gifts for nearby underprivileged children. Our Bible Study, Advent reflections, and Overnight Adoration provide wonderful opportunities to enrich our hearts, minds, and souls with the beautiful stories and truths of our faith. Our priests are available to hear confessions on Saturday afternoons at 12:30pm in the church. We have so many options to make this our best Advent yet, we only need to sign up and make it happen.


