

Last week, we celebrated the Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God. In Greek, her title is "Theotokos", which literally means "God-bearer". This title was given to Our Lady at the beginning of Christianity, and 1st century Christians often sought her intercession by calling out to her as the Mother of God. Even though the title "Theotokos" was the first title given to Our Lady, it is not her only title. She has many more titles that signify and highlight who she is, and they reveal how her intercession can help us. Many of you may know some of her other titles: Undoer of Knots, Perpetual Help, Queen of Heaven and Earth, etc. There is even a litany of Our lady's many titles, the Litany of Loreto, used by the faithful in seeking Our Lady's intercession.

One of the most interesting titles of Our Lady in the Litany of Loreto is the Ark of the Covenant, and I think it is quite beautiful and appropriate to call Mary the Ark of the Covenant. The original Ark of the Covenant was created by God's order during the time after the Israelites escaped from Egypt and were in the desert. It was the most sacred relic of the Israelites and represented the presence of God amongst the Israelites. Later, under King Solomon, the Ark of the Covenant was kept at the most sacred space in the Temple. The Ark was eventually lost after the Israelites were exiled from their homeland.

Then why is Mary called the Ark of the Covenant? The Ark of Covenant carried three things within it as the Israelites were traveling in the desert. First were the stone tablets which contained the Ten Commandments given to Moses by God. Second was a golden jar filled with manna, a miraculous food the Israelites received in the desert, also known as "bread from heaven". Last was Aaron's rod, the rod of a high priest. All three of these things are embodied and made new in Jesus Christ. Christ is the new law given to us from God the Father, reminding us that the greatest commandment is to love God and to love our neighbor. Christ gives us His body and blood in the Most Holy Eucharist. He became the new bread from heaven. Lastly, Christ is the high priest who mediates between God the Father and humanity, and it is through His sacrifice that we are united to the Father!

The one who physically carried Jesus was Mary! She is called the Ark of the Covenant, for she carried within her what the original Ark carried. I recall that in the movie "Indiana Jones and the Raiders of the Lost Ark," those people who opened the Ark perished while Indiana Jones and Marion survived by closing their eyes. There are some truths to this story in a sense that the presence of God which was with the Ark in the Old Testament was too powerful for anyone to gaze upon (Exodus 33). When humanity tries to become equal to God in one way or another, it perishes, for humanity cannot contain the Lord. However, through the new Ark of the Covenant, Mary, the presence of Our Lord became tangible, visible, understandable! God, Himself, contained His Divinity in a single person, Jesus Christ! The Ark of the Old Testament was so powerful that it brought victory in war, but the new Ark brought forth the victor over sin and death!

R.C.I.A.—Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is designed to welcome adults into our Catholic faith. Preparation is a year-long ongoing process culminating at the Easter Vigil Mass. The goal is to receive the Sacraments of Baptism (for non-Christians), Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. IS RCIA FOR YOU or SOMEONE YOU KNOW? 




