

+ Dear Friends:

April is such a beautiful month! We had one of the most joyous Easter weekends given all the COVID restrictions of the past few years. It was truly wonderful seeing all our families for Mass and our youngest parishioners delighting in a very colorful Easter Egg Hunt!

There are even more exciting things happening in April! We just installed two new mosaics in the courtyard area – Saint Elizabeth and Saint Francis. I think they truly add to the prayerfulness of the courtyard, and I hope you will take advantage of spending some re-

flective time there soon.

This is also a very big month for my movie, *Trinity's Triumph*, which is premiering on Thursday, April 27, at the Ridgewood International Film Festival. This project has been 25 years in the making, and it will be the first time that even I am seeing it on the big screen.

*Trinity's Triumph* is the story of three young men, who enter the seminary guided by the wise and loveable mentor, Monsignor Heck, played by Joe Morton. What begins as a single mission becomes divided, and each seminarian must decide what God is asking of him. They struggle individually, with each other, and with God, but soon their answers are clear with the help of Monsignor Heck's influence. In the end, when everyone has found the path that God has in mind for them, they triumph.

When we were shooting, I was honored that Bishop Flesey agreed to be a featured extra in the film. Deena Yellin of the Bergen Record interviewed Bishop Flesey on a very warm day in June 2019, when we were filming in Englewood at Saint Cecilia's. This is an excerpt from her article:

Bishop John Flesey, the auxiliary bishop of the Archdiocese of Newark, played the part of the archbishop in an ordination scene. He told a reporter it was thrilling to be in the movie, although his role wasn't much of a stretch.

"Father Fichter is a very talented priest who loves his ministry and wants to engage people in a positive way," he said. "I've never heard of another priest writing a film before."

He noted that Fichter is an honest, veteran priest who knows about the challenges of the priesthood firsthand and was well-suited to portray the priesthood truthfully.

"I hope people appreciate it," Flesey said. "This is a complex art form."

Once again, I want to thank so many of you who were extras in the film, lent us your cars, or helped with transportation of the actors. All of it contributed to the larger project and made it the success that it has become. I also think you will enjoy recognizing some of the very familiar settings we used for locations. We shot in the bar and the wine room at the Brick House as well as Immaculate Conception Church in Mahwah, St. Cecilia's in Englewood, Fordham University, Caldwell University, Christian Health Care Center, and even our own Saint E's rectory!






