



Dear friends,

Happy Third Sunday of Easter! I hope you were able to take advantage of Divine Mercy Sunday last week. As I mentioned in my homily, I learn something new about this special feast day we celebrate each year on the second Sunday of Easter. With a focus on Works of Mercy, I found a very fitting entry in Saint Faustina's diary that I'd like to share with you again:

"I require you to make acts of mercy, which are to come from your love for Me. You are always and everywhere to show mercy unto your neighbors; you may not withdraw, excuse or absolve yourself from this. I am giving you three ways of performing mercy to your neighbors: first, by **deed**; second, by **word**; and third, by **prayer**; these three levels cover the full scope of mercy, and it is unshakeable evidence that a soul loves Me. This is how the soul praises and honors My mercy." (Diary 742)

We are so fortunate to be part of this generous and loving community which fully embraces Jesus' example and command to serve one another. And although we have over sixty different ministries, there are always our brothers and sisters among us who are in need. If you're looking to get involved, please look at the beautiful ministry guide found on our website. If you've identified a need that is not being addressed, we encourage and support you to act. No matter how small we think our effort is, we may never know how BIG of an impact a small gesture will go to lifting up someone's spirit!

Is there an elderly neighbor who can use help taking out the garbage? Is there someone we know who recently lost a spouse and could use a phone call or visit? I spoke recently with longtime parishioner, Pete Ingrasci, who has ministered to St. Martin's Soup Kitchen for years. Due to recent changes there, he is no longer able to organize our resources to minister to them and has now turned to increasing assistance to the Robert A. Harrison House in Paramus. The Harrison House serves as a safe and secure home for over 95 people living with HIV/ AIDS. Pete's ministry currently serves them one meal each month but he is now looking to increase that number and is in need of additional volunteers. "For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me.' Pope Francis has said that what our world needs is the "medicine of mercy" and Jesus gives us three ways to do this: by **deed**, by **word**, and by **prayer**. 


