It is great to be back at St Elizabeth's! I came here on July 3rd, the feast St. Thomas the Apostle, which actually has meaningful significance for me. At first, Thomas is called Didymus - the Twin - and I am also a twin! Tertullian wrote about Thomas that "He was truly both seen and heard upon the mount; true and real was the draught of that wine at the marriage of (Cana in) Galilee; true and real also was the touch of the then believing Thomas." Believing and seeing are two traits of an Apostle, and they are for me as a disciple of Jesus. In Pope Benedict XVI's general audience on September 27, 2006, he spoke of St. Thomas:

"The Apostle Thomas's case is important to us for at least three reasons," said the Pope. "First, because it comforts us in our insecurity; second, because it shows us that every doubt can lead to an outcome brighter than any uncertainty; and, lastly, because the words that Jesus addressed to him remind us of the true meaning of mature faith and encourage us to persevere, despite the difficulty, along our journey of adhesion to him."

The true meaning of faith is believing that things will work out despite the difficulties as long as our faith is focused on Christ! I look forward to journeying together with all on the discipleship path towards the heavenly kingdom.

After a year long pastoral at Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Ridgewood, I was blessed to be ordained on May 27 for the Archdiocese of Newark. This has a special significance for me, having been born in Newark. After high school, I went to The Culinary Institute of America in Hyde Park NY. God was planting seeds in me there. It was the former St. Andrew's on the Hudson, minor seminary, and it and still has the original church's stained glass windows in the main dining room! The notable Father Pierre Teilhard de Chardin, a theologian whose writings attempt to reconcile science and religion, is buried there. After that, I worked in the culinary industry for about 35 years for companies such as The Waldorf Astoria, Ruth's Chris Steakhouse, Mercedes-Benz, BMW, Paine Webber (now UBS) and Benjamin Moore.

Many will often ask why I chose to be a priest. I answer them by quoting the Gospel of John 15:16: "For you did not choose Me, but I chose you. And I ordained you to go and bear fruit—fruit that will remain—so that whatever you ask the Father in My name, He will give you."

I received not only a Master of Divinity but also an MA in Church History. I learned that St. Thomas was a skilled builder who was invited by the king to construct a palace and is also the Patron Saint of Architects, so coming here on the Feast of St. Thomas has many meaningful connections for me. I do believe in miracles and, for me, being here is one of them! Amen.






