Dearly Beloved in Christ,

Recently, I was in Ghana for my father's funeral celebration. Actually, it was a bitter-sweet moment for me. Bitter in the sense that I will no longer see my dad again, and the vacuum that was created by his demise can never be filled. Then, sweet because there was a family reunion; the members of the family that I have not seen for ages were all present for the funeral. In fact, over 1000 people were at the funeral, with a bishop from the Central African Republic, 70 priests, some religious sisters and brothers, seminarians, pastors of other religious groups, chiefs and elders. Last weekend, the readings dealt with the life God calls us to and the many ways of not living up to that calling. St. Matthew's Gospel tells us that suffering is an integral part of the earthly experience of God's life. Jesus forewarns his disciples of his coming clash with the elders and the chief priests, and of his death and resurrection. It is easily imaginable how disconcerted his disciples are; Peter rebukes Jesus - a suffering Messiah is beyond his comprehension. Jesus makes the condition for being Christian clear: to take up the cross every day. He then contrasts those who seek God's Kingdom with those who dedicate themselves to other purposes. He suggests that even possessing the whole world would pale in comparison to possessing the Kingdom.

The common experiences of life should convince us that we often have to lose something to gain something better. It is no different with our relationship with the Lord our God. Even though it entails suffering, we accept it, and Christ shows us how we gain peace, joy, fulfillment and satisfaction. So, "Whoever loses his/her life for my sake will find it." Through the cross, the central symbol of Christianity, will emerge the resurrection, new life, eternal life with God. Yes, good will triumph over evil; life over death.

We sometimes find ourselves stuck in a Good Friday situation – our problems sometimes batter and may even overwhelm us. In such moments, our faith challenges us to remember that good ultimately will conquer evil, that love transforms hate, that light shatters darkness. The story of Jesus did not end in the tragedy of the cross but in the triumph of the resurrection. Yes, hidden within the mystery of suffering is the glory of the resurrection to eternal life. Let us strive daily to carry our cross, to follow Jesus till the end of our journey of faith.

**2023-2024 Gather the Children Dates:** October 8 & 22, November 5 & 26, December 10, January 7 & 21, February 4 & 25, March 10, April 7 & 28

**R.C.I.A. Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:** RCIA is designed to welcome adults into our Catholic faith. Preparation is a yearlong ongoing process culminating at the Easter Vigil Mass. The goal is to receive the Sacraments of Baptism (for non Christians), Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. IS RCIA FOR YOU or SOMEONE YOU KNOW? Do you know someone or are you someone who is interested in becoming Catholic? Are you Catholic but have not yet received all of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist)? The RCIA is a process of prayer, reflection, and learning that allows for the continual discernment of God's will in our lives. Candidates include: Nonbaptized adults who wish to enter the Catholic Church, baptized adult Christians of another denomination (i.e. Lutheran, Anglican, Presbyterian) who wish to continue their Christian faith in the Catholic Church, adult baptized Catholics who have not completed he Sacraments of Initiation (Holy Communion and/or Confirmation) and wish to do so. 


