How often must I forgive?

In a video I recently saw, a 19 year old man in Israel was riding in the back of a minibus, looking at the noontime sun upon the mountain, when a light blue pickup truck driven by another man barreled into the back of it. The truck hit with an enormous bang. The young man's eardrum broke, his shoe flew off, and he landed on the pavement. In the hospital, it was discovered that his neck was broken and he was now a paraplegic. After many months in the hospital, he learned to breathe on his own, to walk, and to talk; but he mourned for the body he once had. When he went back to New York, he was required to use a wheelchair for

all four years of college. Eventually, he went back to Israel to find the driver who had caused the accident that almost killed him and had profoundly disabled him. When he found the man, he telephoned him. The man seemed almost to have been waiting for the call. The young man asked to meet with him, never mentioning the fact that he learned the driver had 25 driving violations or the number of operations he had to have as a result of the accident. But the young man thought about all he could have been in life - a doctor, a husband, a father. As he drove to the town where he was to meet the man, he was thinking, "What do I get for the man who broke my neck? Flowers?" He settled on pistachio pastries, and they sat in the living room and talked. In doing this, the young man wanted to get to the very heart of Jesus's teaching on forgiveness, that we "all must forgive your brother from your heart." He recalled what the Jewish psychiatrist and writer Victor Frankl - a man who spent three years in four different concentration camps, including Auschwitz, said:

Everything can be taken from a man but one thing: the last of the human freedoms is to choose one's attitude in any given set of circumstances, to choose one's own way. Each moment is a choice. No matter how angry, hurt, constraining or painful our experience, we can always choose how we respond.

Each moment is the moment when we have a choice - when we can choose to "fuhgeddaboudit!" in charity, in the pure love of Christ which is to love God first with all our heart and soul and to love our neighbor as ourself. For forgiving our brother, not just seven times or 77 times, but all the time will change our lives. May God give each of us the fortitude, courage and wisdom of the love of forgiveness. Amen.


