

I know he is excited to see new people saying "yes" to God's call.

In case you didn't have time to stay and explore, some of the other ministries seeking new members include:

- Greeters and Ushers' primary role is one of offering a friendly, welcoming presence to those coming to worship at Mass. They also provide leadership during emergencies, assist parishioners in finding seats, provide help during Communion, and ensure the smooth flow of people in and out of the church.
- The Music Ministry at St. Elizabeth's welcomes everyone to share their talents and love of music with our parish! The ACES children's choir is seeking children between 7 and 14 years old. We bring out the little musician inside of each chorister!. Adult choir members, cantors and instrumentalists are also wanted!
- The Knights of Columbus, founded on the principles of charity, unity and fraternity, was established in 1882 by Father Michael J. McGivney. Our council provides invaluable assistance to those in need in surrounding communities with projects and events such as the annual Coats for Kids Drive, which has just begun.
