Don and his wife Bernadette have been members of Saint Elizabeth Parish since 1999. The pastor at that time was Msgr. Thomas O'Leary, whom Don first met when Don was an undergraduate student at Catholic University and then-deacon O'Leary was completing his theological studies at the university. It was natural for them to join the faith community he was pastoring.

Over the years, their faith has been strengthened by the ministry of the many priests who have been assigned to the parish and by the grace to participate in several of those ministries. Bernadette and Don were team members in the Confirmation preparation program for six years. Bernadette also served on the School Board of Saint Elizabeth's school, until Covid dictated otherwise. She also did yeoman work in helping to create a yet to be completed database of all the alumni of Saint Elizabeth's School. Don was a member of the Parish Council for one term and worked in the St. Martin's food kitchen in Jersey City for several years. He continues to participate in Saint Elizabeth's Food Truck ministry and to serve as a lector at Sunday Mass. He is an occasional eucharistic minister for neighbors and friends, who have become homebound. Finally, for the past seven years, he has been a member of the RCIA team, which has given him the gift of accompanying the candidates and catechumens on their faith journey.






