

Dear friends,

So many of you approached me during Mass inquiring about the work of our new Guardian Ministry that I thought to include more details here for you. Guardian ministers are mostly active and retired law enforcement who attend Mass regularly and are prepared to take action during any type of emergency. Some of the other work we've accomplished in this past year and some future goals include:

- 3 new AEDs (Automatic External Defibrillators) installed in the Narthex, Parish Center and downstairs near the Elizabeth and Youth Rooms.
- \$50k security grant received from the state used to upgrade the security cameras and electronic access control around the campus.
- An Emergency Response Plan mandated by the state and the archdiocese is currently in development.
- Working with the Ushers to improve our awareness and response.
- St. Elizabeth School now has a Wyckoff Police Officer assigned full time (Special Law Enforcement Officer Class 3.)
- The school also added concrete bollards at the entrances to prevent vehicles from getting near the doors (coming soon to the church entrance also.)
- Planning to deliver regular safety and security training on different topics for the community (identity theft, fire safety, first aid, etc.)

It is very hard to believe that Lent is almost upon us! This Wednesday, February 14th, is Ash Wednesday and we expect all of our Masses and prayer services throughout the day to be full, so don't forget your ashes! A friend recently explained to me that he was trying to decide what he was going to "give up" for Lent. He narrowed it down to sweets and sugar but I suggested he also make a commitment to pray every day. As you know, Lent is a special time of the liturgical year when we pray, fast and give alms.

Pope Francis recently wrote in his Lenten message, "Lent is a season of conversion, a time of freedom" during which Christians seek to rediscover God's call and promise. "It is time to act, and in Lent, to act also means to pause. To pause in prayer, in order to receive the word of God, to pause like the Samaritan in the presence of a wounded brother or sister."

R.C.I.A. Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is designed to welcome adults into our Catholic faith. Preparation is a yearlong ongoing process culminating at the Easter Vigil Mass. The goal is to receive the Sacraments of Baptism (for non Christians), Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. IS RCIA FOR YOU or SOMEONE YOU KNOW? Do you know someone or are you someone who is interested in becoming Catholic? Are you Catholic but have not yet received all of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist)? The RCIA is a process of prayer, reflection, and learning that allows for the continual discernment of God's will in our lives. Candidates include: Non-baptized adults who wish to enter the Catholic Church, baptized adult Christians of another denomination (i.e. Lutheran, Anglican, Presbyterian) who wish to continue their Christian faith in the Catholic Church, adult baptized Catholics who have not completed the Sacraments of Initiation (Holy Communion and/or Confirmation) and wish to do so. 

Lenten Regulations

The days of both Fast & Abstinence during Lent are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
 If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily His Resurrection.

The other Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence.

On a day of Fast, only one (1) full meal is permitted and (2) smaller meals which, if added together, would not exceed the main meal in quantity.

Those between the ages of 18-59 are obliged to fast. On a day of Abstinence, no meat may be eaten. Those who have reached the age of 14 are obliged by the law of abstinence.

- The obligation to observe the laws of Fast & Abstinence "substantially" or as whole is a sensous obligation.
- 3. The Fridays of the year, outside of Lent, are designated as days of penance, but each individual may substitute for the traditional abstinence from meat some other practice of voluntary self-denial as penance.
- The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty*) extends from the First Sunday
 of Lent, February 17, 2024 to the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, May 26, 2024.
