My friends at St. Elizabeth's,



Each year on the first Sunday in Lent, we hear the account of Jesus's temptation in the desert. While Mark's version, which we heard last Sunday, is sparse, Matthew's and Luke's versions are far more detailed. The reason we hear these accounts every year is because of its importance in the life of Jesus and its importance in our lives as well. In my homily last week, I spoke about the temptations in the desert being a "Kairos", a moment for Jesus. And so, it is fitting to reflect on this Kairos moment in Jesus' life and what we might learn that will

help us with our own Kairos moments.

The ancient Greeks had two different words for time, "Chronos" and "Kairos." "Chronos" is the word from which we get "chronology," the idea of linear time which is sequential like a clock, a watch, or a calendar. "Kairos" is about a particular moment in time. The focus is on the quality of the time spent. It is often a decisive moment, a moment when a person must act. It is a moment of grace, filled with possibilities. It can be a decision that has life long ramifications.

Each of the temptations experienced by Jesus represented a moment of great consequence, each a moment of grace or a moment of disaster. Each was a Kairos moment where Jesus had to act decisively. The temptations of power, wealth, prestige, and physical pleasure experienced by Jesus are temptations we also experience in our lives. During Lent, we are sent out into the desert of repentance to search our hearts, resist evil, and embrace what is good.

The temptations we face during Lent are likely no different than those faced during the year. The difference is that, during Lent, we have a greater awareness of our weaknesses and our need for repentance. Our Lenten practices of praying, fasting, and almsgiving can make us more receptive to God's saving graces. They can help us to see more clearly the Kairos moments in our own lives. We have many Kairos moments. Some might just seem ordinary, and yet they have monumental consequences.

Perhaps, during Lent, we can go beyond prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Maybe we can also focus on giving a kind word to a stranger, visiting the sick or homebound, picking up the phone to call a friend or family member. It can also be a handwritten note of gratitude or a thank you note to someone who has gone out of their way to help you. These too are Kairos moments which touch the hearts of both the giver and the recipient. They may seem ordinary; yet done at the right moment, these small acts can make a significant difference in a person's life.

This past Ash Wednesday, we began our 40-day Lenten journey. It is a Kairos moment, a decisive moment for all of us to clear away the distractions and spiritual clutter that drag us down. Lent provides us with moments of grace and possibilities for a new beginning and a revival of hope in our lives; a time when we slowly transform ourselves by prayer, fasting, almsgiving and simple acts of kindness. Lent is the "right moment" to repent and to believe in the Gospel, the good news of Jesus Christ. May our Lenten practices make us more aware of the Kairos moments in our lives and remind us of God's love and mercy.

Have a blessed and fruitful Lent!



Lenten Regulations

The days of both Fast & Abstinence during Lent are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vipil (on Holy Saturday
might) as the "pacchal fast" to honer the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare
ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more seadily His Resurrection.

The other Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence.

On a day of Fast, only one (1) full meal is permitted and (2) smaller meals which, if added together, would not exceed the main meal in quantity.

Those between the ages of 18-59 are obliged to fast. On a day of
Abstinence, no meat may be eaten. Those who have reached the age of 14 are obliged by
the law of abstinence.

- 3. The Fridays of the year, outside of Lent, are designated as days of penance, but each individual may substitute for the traditional abstinence from mest some other practice of voluntary self-denial as penance.
- The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty*) extends from the First Sunday of Lent, February 17, 2024 to the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, May 26, 2024.
