

Dear St. Elizabeth's friends,

In my homily last week, I spoke about the US Bishops' call for a three-year National Eucharistic Revival. The first year was focused on the diocesan level. The current year of the revival is focused on the parish level. The third year's focus, which begins in a couple of weeks, is on missionary discipleship.

As you read this bulletin column, something very exciting is happening in our country! Processing from the four corners of the United States is one of the largest Eucharistic pilgrimages in history. Over one hundred thousand pilgrims are walking 6,500 miles through cities and rural towns, along highways and dusty county roads with our Eucharistic Lord. They are coming from San Francisco, California; Brownsville, Texas; from the headwaters of the mighty Mississippi River and New Haven, Connecticut. They will converge at Indianapolis, Indiana on July 16, in time for the first National Eucharistic Congress in the United States in 83 years!

This is an exciting time for our Church and for our nation as God pours out His grace on all of us, enkindling in us the flame of His love and mercy. However, the National Eucharistic Congress is not intended to be the conclusion of the revival. Rather, it is intended to transform each of us so that we can be sent out to share Christ's love to a world in desperate need of it.

At our baptism, you and I were anointed as Priest, Prophet, and King, sharers in Christ's mission of salvation. This means that you and I are prophets whose role is to read the signs of the times by being sensitive to the needs of those around us; to bring peace, mercy, justice and hope; to be the voice for the ordinary, the powerless, the rejected, the unworthy. Pope Francis tells us that it is the Eucharist that puts us in "tune with the heart of Christ." Our National Eucharist Revival reminds us that we are Eucharistic people, that we become what we eat and drink - the Eucharist for others!

It is the Eucharist that gives us the nourishment and the strength to carry out our prophetic mission as disciples of Christ. St. Teresa of Calcutta reminds us we are not called to be successful but to be faithful to our mission. She goes on to say that "Every person is Christ for me." I would argue that this was her prophetic mission and it is also ours as missionary disciples of Christ.

The Eucharist is the food for the soul that empowers us to proclaim HIM who gave us the Eucharist. Let us do so boldly with conviction, glorifying HIM with our lives as people of the Eucharist! I'd like to close my column with an excerpt from the Eucharistic Revival Prayer:

Jesus living in the Eucharist, come and live in me.

Jesus healing in the Eucharist, come and heal me.

Jesus sacrificing yourself in the Eucharist, come and suffer in me.

Jesus rising in the Eucharist, come and rise to new life in me.


Jesus loving in the Eucharist, come and love in me.

RCIA, the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is an ongoing process of prayer, reflection and learning that allows for the continual discernment of God's will in our lives. It is a year-long process, culminating at the Easter Vigil Mass, that is designed to welcome adults into our Catholic faith. Are you interested in or do you know someone who is interested in becoming Catholic? Are you Catholic but have not received all of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation)? Candidates include: non-baptized adults who wish to enter the Catholic Church, baptized adult Christians of other denominations (ex., Lutheran, Anglican, Presbyterian, etc.), and adult baptized Catholics who have not completed the Sacraments of Initiation and wish to do so. 


