

This past Sunday, we heard what was the culmination of Jesus's preaching on "The Bread of Life." This comes from the 6th chapter of the Book of John and is often referred to as the "Bread of Life" discourse. The reason the Church gives us weeks of Gospel readings from this discourse during the summer is to highlight the importance of Jesus's instruction about the Eucharist. One of the most beautiful teachings that the Catholic Church highlights is the importance of the Eucharist and of the regular reception of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, not simply in a symbolic way, but in a mystical, actual way. The Church highlights this reality with such prominence because Christ Himself stressed how necessary it is to consume His flesh and blood fro us to receive eternal life. There is no question that this is a difficult teaching of Jesus, one that is often misunderstood, misinterpreted, or, worst of all, simply ig-

nored. We heard about how some of the followers of Christ at that time began to seriously doubt Jesus and His teachings after hearing this discourse, and how some even returned to their former ways of life. When we are faced with a difficult teaching from Christ or, in a broader sense, when we are faced with a difficult reality in our lives, how do we respond? Are we like those disciples in the Gospel who begin to grumble and walk away? Or are we like Peter who, when asked by Christ if he too was going to leave, responds, "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life." The reality of doubt in God's design for our lives can affect each of us at some point in life. Though it may be tempting to walk away when faced with difficulty, we must remember the words of Peter and ask God to help us cast out whatever doubt we might have about His love and care for us. No good comes from doubting the Love of God and we must put it from our minds, and ask the Lord to give us a renewed and stronger faith. And we must be mindful that with God, nothing is impossible.
