Dear St. Elizabeth's Parishioners,

Last Sunday was the first day of Advent and the first day of our new liturgical year. As I noted in my homily, during our liturgical celebrations over the next four weeks, we will light our Advent Wreath. The candle I lit last week represents hope. The candle this week signifies peace, next week's is joy, and the candle for the last week of Advent symbolizes love. Each week, as we light more candles, the wreath will grow brighter, reminding us that Christ is close, and His presence enlightens our lives.

Our Advent Wreath signifies that light chases away the darkness, bringing us hope for a new tomorrow. During Advent, we strive to keep our focus on the true light that never diminishes – the light of Christ – an eternal light that gives us hope for salvation. Advent gives us an opportunity to pause, to step back a bit, to see through the gloom of the night as we wait in hopeful expectation for the coming of the Lord. His spiritual light guides us and leads us to safety. He wants to heal our brokenness and to comfort us through the darkest hour of our lives.

During Advent, we prepare for the annual remembrance of Christ's birth 2,000 years ago. It is also a time when we wait and prepare for Christ's final coming as the King of Glory who will sit in judgment of the living and the dead. But during Advent, we also prepare for the third coming of Christ - Emanuel – which means "God with us." Christ is among us. We have Him in the Eucharist. We can find Him in the lost and the lonely, the poor, the marginalized, the sick, and in those who grieve. Advent is a visible reminder of our call – both the laity and the ordained - NOT just to be followers of the light of the world, but to carry forth that light into a dark and broken world as beacons of hope!

Being beacons of hope does not end with Advent. Next year, Pope Francis has declared a Jubilee Year with the theme Pilgrims of Hope. He will begin the year with the opening of the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica on Christmas Eve, December 24, 2024. In his letter declaring the Jubilee Year of Hope, the Pope writes:

We must fan the flame of hope that has been given us and help everyone to gain new strength and certainty by looking to the future with an open spirit, a trusting heart and far-sighted vision. The forthcoming Jubilee can contribute greatly to restoring a climate of hope and trust as a prelude to the renewal and rebirth that we so urgently desire..."

In February of next year, I will be traveling to Rome to participate in an international study conference and the Jubilee Year of Hope with deacons from seventeen countries around the world. The conference is titled, Deacons: Joyful Witnesses to Hope. I will write more about my upcoming trip in my next bulletin article.

It is my prayer for this Advent and beyond that each of us will fan the flame of hope in our ministries, families, workplaces, and communities. So, let us begin the work! Strike the match, start the flame, spread the light. Be beacons of hope!

Denis and his wife, Mary Ellen, joined both the parish of Saint Elizabeth and the community of Wyckoff in 1974. Their two sons, Denis and Patrick, are graduates of Saint Elizabeth School, and both boys were married at Saint Elizabeth Church by the late Father Frank O'Connor. The family has experienced the transitioning of the parish priests from Franciscan to Archdiocesan, the closing of the old church and opening of the new church in 1992, and the addition of the chapel in 2020.

During the years, the family took part in Saint Martin's Food Kitchen in Jersey City. For many years, Mary Ellen was a CCD teacher for the primary grades, while Denis was involved in the food ministry. Both were Eucharistic Ministers at the Christian Health Care Center (CHCC). They joined the ministry of the Our Lady of Fatima Pilgrim Statue. Mary Ellen passed in February 2021. Prior to her passing, Denis was Eucharistic Minister to her and a neighbor who had become homebound. Denis continues to serve as a Eucharistic Minister at CHCC, has joined the overnight Eucharistic Adoration ministry, and has altered his participation in the food ministry by preparing the monthly "brown bags" and substituting as an assistant on the food van.

By participating in the various ministries including worship and social concerns, Denis believes that he and his family have been able to share in the motto of Saint Elizabeth's parish: Eucharist, Service, Tenderness.






