

Dear friends at St. Elizabeth's,

Our scripture readings last week encouraged us to be persistent in our prayer life and in our faith journey, most especially when we are faced with great difficulties in our lives. It is easy to lose hope, to become bitter and lose our way along our life's journey. I can just visualize the disciples, after following Jesus for a couple of years, growing fatigued and weary. They likely had suffered trials and difficulties and sometimes even ridicule from their fellow Jews. Maybe they were feeling discouraged. But Jesus tells them the parable about the widow and the unjust judge that we heard in the Gospel to

encourage them to pray without becoming weary, to give them strength and encouragement.

Often, amid our own trials and tribulations, it is difficult to be persistent in prayer without becoming disheartened. Don't we often wonder does God hear our prayers? Yet, He is here, he is among us – in his holy scriptures, his ministers, the assembly and, most especially, in the gift of the Eucharist. God became one of us through the incarnation – the word made flesh. He understands our joys and sorrows, our successes and our failures. He hears our prayers and encourages us to be faithful and to be persistent, especially when we feel alone, abandoned, brokenhearted or rejected.

During our most challenging times, we need the help and support of our friends and faith community so that we do not grow weary. Our journey of prayer and faith requires not just persistence but also a community - the faith community of our friends and family to help us sustain our faith journey, to hold each other up when we tire and need help. During this Jubi lee Year of Hope, you and I travel together as pilgrims on a journey of prayer and faith. The Jubilee Prayer below, written by Pope Francis, is intended to give us hope and to sustain and encourage our faith as we journey toward our ultimate destination.

Jubilee Prayer

Father in heaven, may the faith you have given us in your son, Jesus Christ, our brother, and the flame of charity enkindled in our hearts by the Holy Spirit, reawaken in us the blessed hope for the coming of your Kingdom.

May your grace transform us
into tireless cultivators of the seeds of the Gospel.
May those seeds transform from within
both humanity and the whole cosmos
in the sure expectation
of a new heaven and a new earth,
when, with the powers of Evil vanquished,
your glory will shine eternally.

May the grace of the Jubilee reawaken in us, Pilgrims of Hope, a yearning for the treasures of heaven.
May that same grace spread the joy and peace of our Redeemer throughout the earth.
To you our God, eternally blessed, be glory and praise for ever.
Amen.

May our faith grow strong and remain resilient as we journey together through the Jubilee Year of Hope and beyond!


