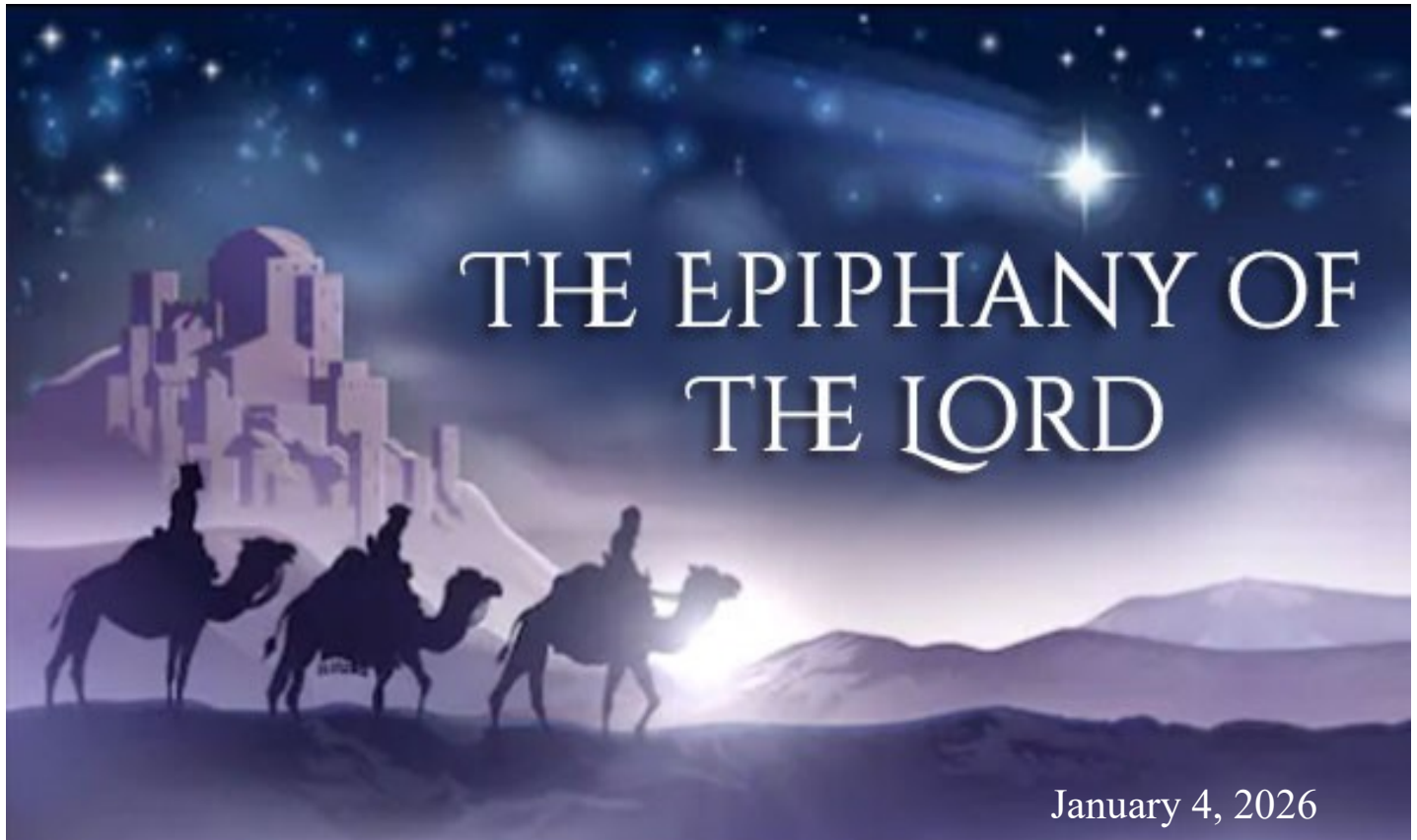

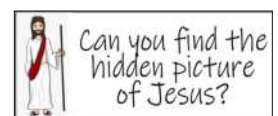

Happy New Year!!!

On behalf of Fr. Stephen, Fr. Joseph, Fr. Robert, Deacon John, and the entire staff at St. Elizabeths, we wish you a blessed New Year with joy and peace for you and your family!!

This weekend is the Epiphany of the Lord. I have often thought of the perilous and dangerous 1,000-mile journey made by the Magi from Persia following a star in the night sky. The Magi did not know where the star would take them, or what their destination would be, but they trusted in the light. They followed a star - the bright light in the night sky - in search of the King of the Jews!

I wonder what must have been on the minds of the Magi as they approached the stable and found a baby boy lying in an animal feeding trough? Yet, through the darkness 2,000 years ago the Magi found God in a forgotten corner of the world, among a forgotten people, beneath the light of a star and were so profoundly changed. The world was changed! Because God humbled himself to become one of us – like you and me - so that we can be like him.

The miracle of the Feast of the Epiphany is that Christ reveals himself to us so that we in turn can be light for others. Each of us in our own way are to be shining stars, beacons of light and hope through the witness of our life by bringing the light of Christ’s love to those in darkness.

As I was writing this bulletin article, I came across a homily delivered by my dad. We all have shining stars guiding us in life. He was mine. I would like to share his words with you.

*There are stars in the entertainment fields and in the field of sports – those who have appeal to a large audience. Then there are the real stars, Mother Theresa, and others – they are stars at living because they followed their star – the star of Bethlehem, Jesus Christ.  
Perhaps a definition of a star is needed. Let’s say a star is anyone who brings light or joy into what might otherwise be a dark or hopeless situation. It could be a person who simply wipes away a tear or brings a smile. It could be a person who feeds the hungry, gives drink to the thirsty, welcomes the stranger, clothes naked, comforts the ill, or visits the prisoner. A star is someone whose very presence and actions are really the presence of our Lord at work in the world on our behalf. - Deacon Al Saunders, Feast of the Epiphany, January 5, 1997.*

Many of us make New Year’s resolutions to eat a little better, exercise a little more or change our unhealthy habits. These are all good and worth considering. My resolution this year is to better live out the wise words of my dad. They are as relevant to me today as they were 28 years ago. Our presence, our actions, especially with the poor, the marginalized, the sick, and the lonely, are really the presence of our Lord in our world operating through us. We do not need to do important things. Just small things with love according to Mother Teresa.

So, let the light of Christ, the Star of Bethlehem, shine in and through us for all the world to see.


